Narrative:

On May 11, 2026, at approximately 1100 hours, BCI was contacted by the Bucyrus Police Department in reference to an officer involved critical incident. The incident began as a domestic violence situation on May 10, 2026, at approximately 2230 hours. An exchange of gunfire occurred in the late morning of May 11, 2026. The subject, Paul Desmarias, was deceased on scene. Bucyrus Police Department requested assistance with the examination of the scene and collecting potential evidence. Special Agent (SA) Roberts, Crime Scene Technician's (CST) Miller and Brandenburg-Cook accepted the request.

CST Miller arrived on scene, 905 E Warren Street, Bucyrus, Ohio, at approximately 1250 hours. SA Roberts and CST Brandenburg-Cook arrived a short time later. Weather conditions at the time of arrival were partly cloudy and approximately 61 degrees Fahrenheit.

The crime scene was secure at the time of arrival. Personnel cordoned off the area with crime scene tape. The roadways were blocked off and law enforcement officials from multiple agencies were actively protecting the scene.

The Ashland County Bomb Squad was actively searching the residence for potential explosive material.

A search warrant to examine the residence was signed by Judge Leuthold of Crawford Municipal Court. A photocopy of the warrant was provided to CST Brandenburg-Cook and the scene was photographed as found.

The scene was scanned outside using a Leica RTC scanner and BLK scanner for the inside by SA Roberts. A diagram of the scene was completed by SA Roberts, and a drone was also deployed for photo documentation. The digital data was uploaded into axon.

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The scene was located in a two-story white sided house with red shutters. The house was located on the south side of East Warren Street. The front of the house contained one (1) door that faced west. One (1) additional door was found on the south side of the house. There is an alley way on the south side of the property that gives access to a detached garage and a gravel driveway that leads into the backyard of the residence. An elevated wooden deck leads to the south door located at the rear of the residence.

Significant structural damage was observed throughout the two-story residence. Large sections of the exterior of the house were missing, allowing a clear line of sight from the front of the house through the interior and out the back. Multiple windows were shattered, and a substantial amount of OC gas remained present inside the structure. A front-end loader had been utilized to lift a portion of the front porch to facilitate the

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placement of a supporting beam. Glass and exterior debris were scattered both inside and outside the residence. Overall, the home was in a state of severe disarray.

Multiple vehicles were present in the road to the north of the house. One (1) vehicle was present in the detached garage, and two (2) additional vehicles were present in the rear property of the residence just off the ally way. The vehicles information are as follows:

It should be noted there was a ladder leaning against the garage in the area of camera #1. During the time of scene examination, the camera was found on the ground in front of the garage door.

SA Emahiser verified on scene the cameras were wifi enabled.

Located to the south of the white truck was a tripod containing a firearm pointed in the northern direction. Directly below the firearm was one (1) fired cartridge casing. The firearm was a Tikka T3x rifle with Viper Cortex mounted scope. The firearm contained a seated magazine with seven (7) HORNADY 308 WIN cartridges and one (1) HORNADY 308 WIN cartridge in the chamber. The firearm, magazine, and cartridges were placed into a cardboard box, sealed with clear tape, and retained as **BCI Item # 1**. The fired cartridge casing found beneath the firearm "HORNADY 308 WIN" was placed into manila envelope, sealed with clear tape, and retained as **BCI Item #2**.

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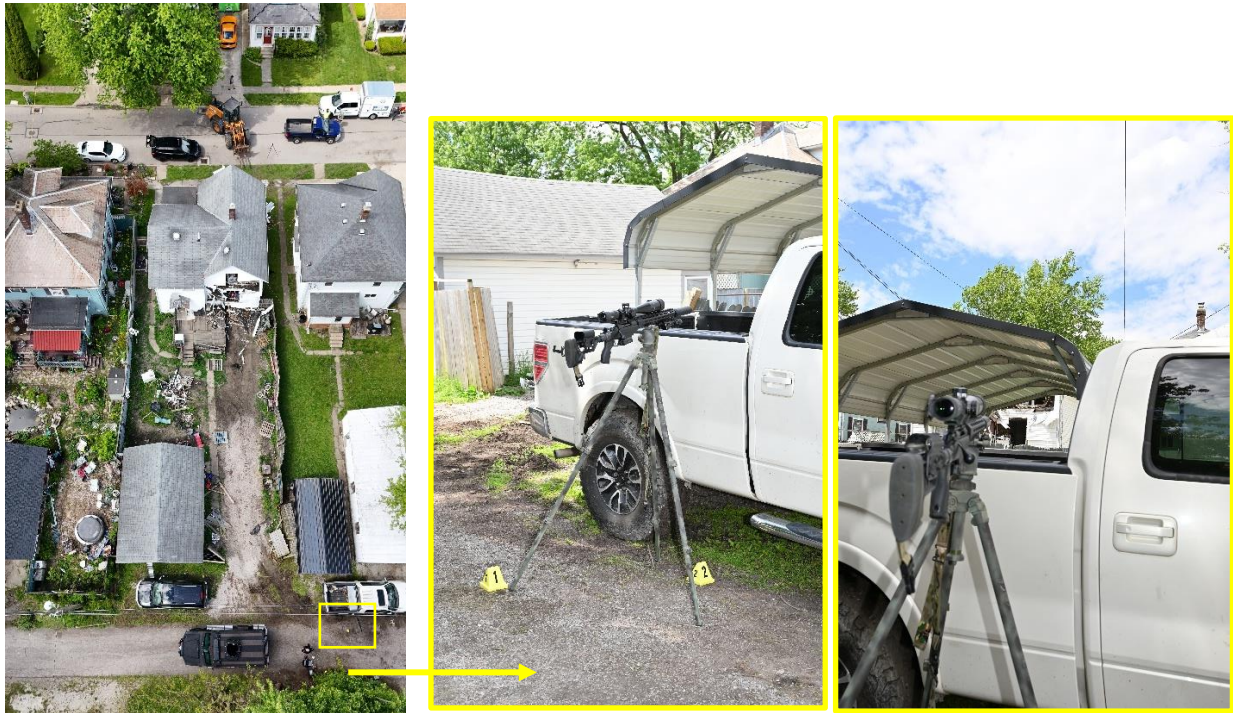


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A ballistic impact was located in the rear fence located on the property.

Ballistic Impact (BI) 1. This ballistic impact was located on the fence in the south area of the property at 905 E. Warren Street. The impact was approximately 3'6" from the ground and 4" from the west side of the fence. Corresponding impacts were located in the fence and black Chrysler Aspen vehicle. BI 1.0 was irregular in shape and the wood was pushed inward, while BI 1.1 had wood that pushed outward and away from the point of impact. This indicates the trajectory of the bullet came from the north side of the fence toward the south side before striking the vehicle (i.e. directionality from within the property out towards the alley). A trajectory rod was unable to be placed due to the hygroscopic material of the wood. The flight path of the bullet perforated the wood panel of the fence and ricocheted off the lower back quarter panel of the Chrysler Aspen vehicle. The fired bullet was located on the ground to the north of the vehicle (**BCI Item #3**).

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Interior Examination of the Scene

The interior of the residence was searched. The residence was comprised of five (5) rooms on the main/first floor and five (5) rooms on the second floor. On the first floor moving from south to north, the rooms include: one (1) laundry room that contained stairs accessing the basement, one (1) bathroom, one (1) kitchen, one (1) living room that contained stairs accessing the second story, and one (1) playroom. On the second floor moving through the residence from north to south, two (2) bedrooms, one (1) closet, one (1) bathroom, and an additional bedroom.

Numerous firearms, large quantities of ammunition, and tactical gear were located throughout the residence. During the investigation, it was determined that the Bucyrus Police Department would collect and retain the majority of firearms and ammunition, as they were not in the immediate area where the decedent was found. SA Emahiser assisted the Bucyrus Police Department with the collection of the items from the residence for safekeeping. Refer to SA Emahiser's report for additional details.

The residence was unkept and in significant disarray. Numerous cigarette butts, garbage, alcohol bottles, and trash were found in and throughout the residence. Multiple items were found throughout the home and retained as evidence. The items were located in the kitchen, living room, upstairs bathroom, north bedroom and southwest bedroom.

Examination of Southeast Bedroom

The southeast bedroom was in complete disarray. A substantial portion of the exterior wall was missing and a significant amount of wood and siding debris was observed on the floor in the small hallway that gave access to the room. A dresser was present in the corner of the bedroom. A bunkbed was present and oriented in a northwest to southeast direction. Multiple items including ammunition, firearms, tactical gear, and bone fragments were present. Apparent blood was on the floor, mattress, ceiling and walls. Multiple areas of damage were present in the drywall.

The deceased, Paul Desmarais, was found in the southeast bedroom. He was found in a semi seated position, lying on his left side of the floor to the west of the bunk bed. His right and left arms were bent at the elbow. His right leg was folded beneath him and his left leg was bent at the knee extending to the west wall. One foot was oriented to the west and the other to the east. His head was to the east with his face directed south. Rigor was observed. He was clothed in blue jeans, black tennis shoes, black t-shirt, and tactical lead plated vest. A magazine containing twenty-nine (29) "LC 24" cartridges was present in the decedent's front left pocket (**BCI Item #50**). Attached to the decedent's right hip was a holster that contained a Ruger P94 handgun. The firearm contained a seated magazine containing a total of ten (10) cartridges; one (1) WIN 40 S&W cartridge and nine (9) WINCHESTER 40 S&W cartridges. One (1) WINCHESTER 40

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S&W cartridges was found in the chamber. The firearm, magazine, and cartridges were placed into a cardboard box, sealed with clear tape, and retained as **BCI Item # 44**.



Desmarais was found with a grey sweatshirt placed over his head. Upon removal of the sweatshirt, it was observed that the entire upper portion of his skull was missing. Bone fragments were present throughout the room on the floor and on the bed.

Desmarais hands and arms had multiple symmetrical and irregular shaped stains ranging in approximate size from submillimeter to 20mm in a random distribution. The stains were mostly present on the dorsal side of the hands.

Multiple firearms were present in the immediate area of Desmarais, with one firearm attached to the deceased by a strap (BCI Item #35). A gas mask, tactical equipment, cartridge casings, cartridges, and magazines containing cartridges were found in abundance.

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The Crawford County Coroner ordered the body to be transported to the Lucas County Coroner's Office for further examination. The body of Paul Desmarais was placed into a clean body bag and transported at approximately 2030 hours. Once Desmarais body was removed from the scene additional items of evidence were identified.

Multiple ballistic impacts were located on the interior south wall of the bedroom (Exterior wall is missing) as well as on the interior west wall (towards the stairwell).

Ballistic Impact (BI) 3, Ballistic Impact (BI) 5, and Ballistic Impact (BI) 6. These ballistic impacts were located on the interior south wall. They were located in a random distribution that ranged from the west wall of the bedroom to 2' to the east. They ranged from approximately 2' through 2'9" from the floor. The area of impact(s) were symmetrical in shape and had a portion of the drywall pushed in, indicating the direction was from the interior of the room towards the exterior of the house. Corresponding impacts were located on the south hallway side of the same wall. Trajectory rods were unable to be placed due to the presence of foam insulation and wood perforations. The flight path of the bullets perforated the interior south wall into the south hallway. The exterior wall of the house was missing. No further impacts could be located. No bullets were recovered.

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Bullet impacts on interior south wall of bedroom.

Ballistic Impact (BI) 4. This ballistic impact was located on the interior south wall. The impact was approximately 3' from the floor and 3" from the west wall of the bedroom. A corresponding impact was located on the south hallway side of the same wall. The area of impact was symmetrical in shape and had a portion of the drywall pushed in, indicating the direction was from the interior of the room towards the exterior of the house. The flight path of the bullet perforated the interior south wall into the south hallway. The exterior wall of the house was missing. No further impacts could be located. A bullet was not recovered.

A trajectory rod was inserted into ballistic impact 4.0 and trajectory measurements were completed by CST Miller with MAP360 software. Please refer to the attached report for results. The bullet was not recovered.

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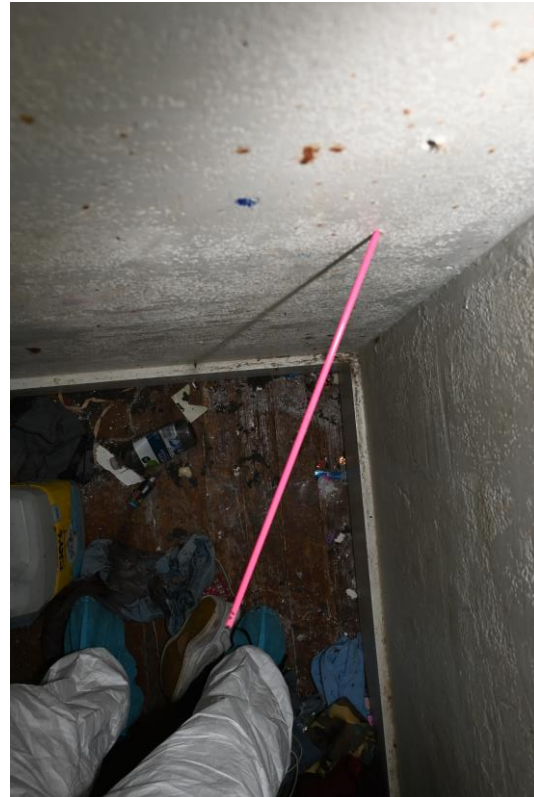


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Side view of BI 4.0

Ballistic Impact (BI) 7. This ballistic impact was located on the interior south wall. The impact was approximately 2' from the floor and 2' from the west wall of the bedroom. No corresponding impacts could be located. The area of impact had a portion of the drywall pushed in, indicating the direction was from the interior of the room towards the exterior of the house. A trajectory rod was not placed. The flight path of the bullet penetrated the interior south wall. A bullet was not recovered.

Approximately five (5) more additional ballistic impacts were present on the interior west wall of the bedroom. The impacts were in a random distribution extending approximately 3'3" to 4'8" from the interior south wall of the bedroom to approximately 6.5" to 1'6" above the floor. Corresponding impacts were located on the hallway side of the same wall. The area of impacts were irregular in shape and exhibited portions of drywall pushed inward, indicating the direction was from the interior of the room towards the hallway/stairwell of the residence. Trajectory rods were unable to be placed due to the presence of foam insulation. The flight path of the bullets perforated the interior west wall into the central hallway/stairwell. No further

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impacts could be located. No bullets were recovered. *Note: BCI Item #13 (fired bullet) was found in the hallway and may possibly be associated with one of the impacts.*



Ballistic impacts on west wall of bedroom

A suspected bloodstain pattern covered a large portion of the adjoining north and west walls of the bedroom. The pattern extended across an 8'5" by 10'2" section of wall and radiated outward in all directions. Multiple symmetrical, elliptical, and irregular shaped stains ranging in approximated size from submillimeter to 10mm were observed. Centrally located in the suspected bloodstain pattern was a large concentration of bloodstain with portions of the stain appearing to be affected by gravity.

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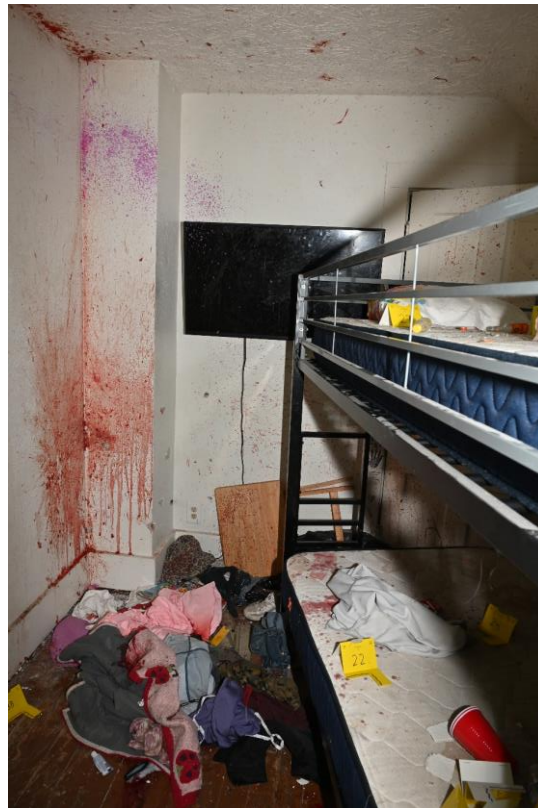

Sa Roberts transported the items of evidence from the scene and took them to the Bowling Green BCI office where she secured them. A copy of the search warrant and evidence inventory list was left inside the residence.

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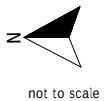
ballistic impact

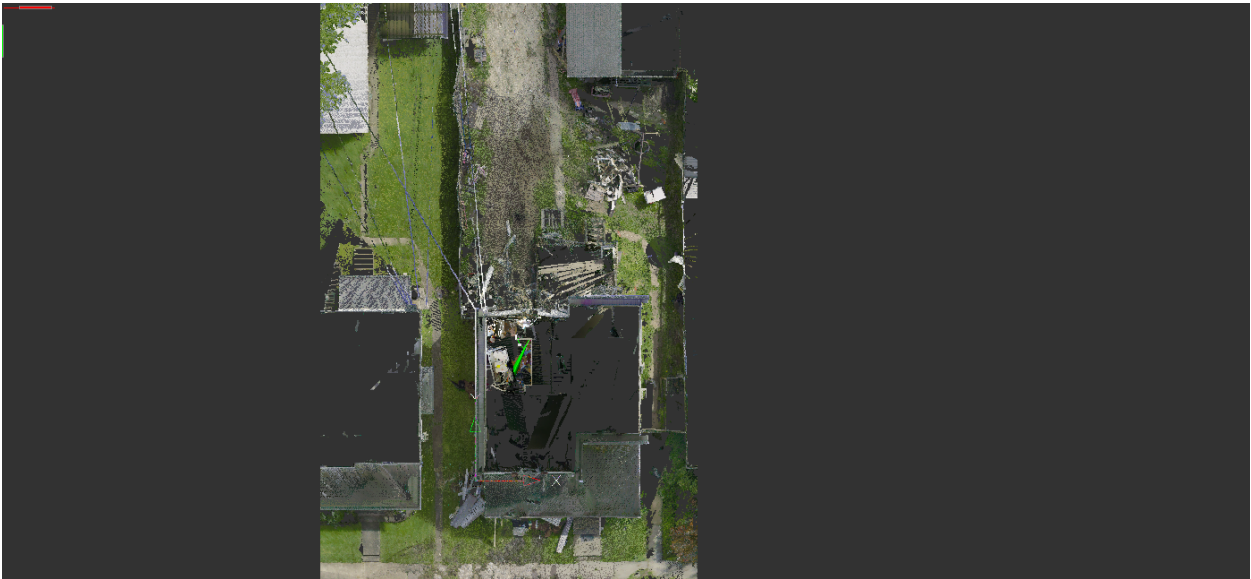
