**Narrative:**

On Wednesday, September 24, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jesse Bynum (SA Bynum) received requested records and recordings from Brunswick Police Department (BPD). SA Bynum had previously requested all dispatch records, audio recordings (radio, 911, and phone), mobile data terminal (MDT) communications, and any other dispatch/communications-related information for the following incident related to the September 18, 2025, officer involved critical incident which occurred in Brunswick, Ohio. As a result of that request, the following items were received and reviewed:

Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) Records

CAD reports were provided by BPD. The documents show the date and times of officers dispatched to 15 Pearl Rd, Brunswick, Ohio. The documents also show a narrative of the calls BPD Dispatch received at the time of the OICI.

The CAD records provided by BPD were received and found to be in line with the information obtained from radio traffic and dispatch calls.

The sections below of the BPD CAD reports were of note:

A female caller advised BPD Dispatch, stating she called before, and that the unknown subject was breaking glass and all the pumps. The caller described the subject as short, and wearing a red shirt, and a white male.

The unknown caller was on the phone with BPD Dispatch as well as the clerk in the store. The unknown caller was telling Vempati to hide under the counter and telling dispatch to hurry up. The duration of the video was 57 seconds. The call abruptly stopped at the 57 second mark.

An unknown female caller advised BPD Dispatch that a male was trying to break her window. The caller was driving a Honda CRV, when she noticed a man walking in the roadway and approached her car. The man attempted to open her car door, followed by him punching her passenger window before she drove away.

Dispatch advised Vempati to lock herself in somewhere safe, Vempati stated she locked herself behind a door. The unknown subject began to gain access to the room Vempati was in. In the background of the call, the subject could be heard saying "open the door. (01:25 mark)" as well as banging on the door.

The officer advised her to come to the police station so he could take pictures of the vehicle as well as any possible damage.

Matsko agreed to come to the police station to make a written statement.




