Narrative:

On Thursday, January 29, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed the requested audio-recording of the radio traffic from the Lorain Police Department (LPD) related to the officer involved critical incident (OICI) which occurred on January 21, 2026, at 24496 Clareshire Drive, North Olmsted, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

The summary below is not intended to be a word for word translation of every radio transmission which occurred before, during, or after the incident, except where indicated. Rather, the information listed documents the radio traffic that was deemed by the author to be the most relevant and useful in obtaining an understanding of the radio traffic related to the OICI.

As there is no date or time stamp on the audio recording provided by the LPD, the times listed will be the elapsed time from the beginning of the recording. The audio recording can be found documented as "Radio Traffic" and can be found as Reference Item E which is stored in AXON JUSTICE. The overall length of the audio recording is 15:20. All of the officers on the audio recording are LPD Officers. Where known, the officers will be identified by name. Other references listed simply as "officers" will be for unknown/unidentified officers.

It should also be noted that the large breaks in places of the documented radio transmissions are when the pursuit was occurring and the units involved were calling out the direction of the pursuit, speed, traffic volume, and roadway conditions (wet, dry, etc.).

SA Tingley reviewed the radio traffic audio-recording and noted the following which is documented in the following table:

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Time of Recording	Radio Traffic
00:09	Dispatch notified LPD Officers: "EPD (Elyria Police Department) just had a Brinks truck robbed at gunpoint in their city...It was last seen heading northbound from West River...They described it as a black Hyundai...King, Paul, Mary, 5,5,6,9." (License plate KPM 5569)
04:56	Officer stated the suspect vehicle was northbound on Elyria Avenue
05:45	Officer stated the suspect vehicle was now southbound on Broadway Avenue
06:30	Officer stated: "He's swerving that car at units."
12:09	Pursuing LPD units are ordered to terminate the lead in the pursuit once EPD took over as lead in the pursuit
13:24	Officer stated that spikes (a tire deflation device) were set/deployed at Clay Road
13:28	Officer stated that EPD took over the lead in the pursuit
13:58	Officer stated that it appeared that the suspect vehicle had crashed
14:23	Officer stated that the suspect was shot and was down. He also stated that all of the Officers were safe.
14:54	Officer Rivera stated that the location of the OICI was 24496 Clareshire Drive in North Olmsted
