Narrative:

On Monday, January 12, 2026, the Euclid Police Department (EPD) requested Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) assistance at the scene of an officer-involved critical incident at 1451 East 219th Street, Euclid, Ohio. As part of that investigation, Special Agent (SA) Darien Spann (SA Spann) was requested to attend the post-mortem examination of the decedent. The examination was conducted on January 12, 2026, at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office in Cleveland, Ohio. The post-mortem examination was conducted by Dr. Krywanczyk.

The following observations were made during the course of the autopsy:
