## APPROVAL—CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE OF OHIO ON BEHALF OF BOWLING GREEN UNIVERSITY AND GEORGE KILGEN AND SON, INC., OF ST. LOUIS, MO., FOR A PIPE ORGAN INSTALLED IN THE AUDITORIUM.

## COLUMBUS, OHIO, September 11, 1937.

## HON. CARL G. WAHL, Director, Department of Public Works, Columbus, Ohio.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio by Carl G. Wahl, Director of Public Works, acting for and on behalf of the Board of Trustees of Bowling Green State University, Bowling Green, Ohio, and George Kilgen & Son, Inc., of St. Louis, Mo., for a Pipe Organ to be installed in the Auditorium of Bowling Green State University of Bowling Green, Ohio, which contract calls for the total expenditure of eleven thousand eight hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$11,875.00).

You have also submittd the form of proposal properly signed by the contractor, which proposal is secured by a bond with the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland as surety, in the amount of \$26,328.00. The bond is properly signed by an attorney in fact, with the power of attorney, and its certificate of compliance with the insurance laws of the State of Ohio. Also included with the papers submitted is the estimate of cost, the affidavit of publication, tabulation of bids, the recommendation of the State Architect and Engineer to the Board of Trustees of Bowling Green State University, the direction of the Board of Trustees of the University to enter into this contract, the approval of the PWA in Ohio, the certificate of the President of the Board of Trustees that the necessary funds are available for the payment of the University's portion of this contract, and a certificate of compliance by the contractor with the workmen's compensation laws of the State of Ohio.

Finding said contract and bond in proper legal form, I have this day noted my approval thereon and return the same herewith to you, together with all other pertinent papers submitted in this connection.
