Narrative:

Search Warrant Obtained

Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joseph Goudy (Goudy) drafted a search warrant for Medical Records of Ricardo Davis (Davis), relative to the officer-involved critical incident which occurred on February 24, 2026.

On Thursday, February 26, 2026, SA Goudy met with Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas Judge Kevin Kelley (Judge Kelley). Judge Kelley reviewed the search warrant and search warrant affidavit. On , February 26, 2026 at approximately 1045 hours, Judge Kelley signed / authorized the search warrant.

Search Warrant Executed

On Thursday, February 26, 2026, at approximately 1145 hours, SA Goudy executed / served the aforementioned search warrant by submitting a copy of the signed search warrant to the Metro Health Medical Center – Records Department.

During the search, the following items of potential evidence were seized:

- Medical Records of the subject/decedent, Davis, from the day he was admitted. The records were received via electronic mail on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, at approximately 0832 hours.

An inventory of the items seized was prepared with a copy provided to Metro Health Hospital.

Search Warrant Returned

On Thursday, March 05, 2026, SA Goudy met with Judge Kevin Kelley. Judge Kelley reviewed and signed the search warrant return. On March 5, 2026, SA Goudy filed the original search warrant, search warrant affidavit, inventory, and search warrant return with the Cuyahoga County Clerk of Courts.

SEARCH WARRANT

TO: The Superintendent of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations and/or Special Agent Joseph Goudy #83, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation and/or any Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Agent, and/or any other duly authorized law Enforcement Officer.

WHEREAS there has been filed with me an affidavit, a copy of which is attached here as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein as though fully rewritten, wherein the affiant avers that he has reasonable cause to believe and does believe that within the premises known as Metro Health Hospital, located at 2500 Metro Health Drive, Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, and further described as a health care provider facility/hospital, there is now being kept, concealed and possessed the following evidence of a criminal offense:

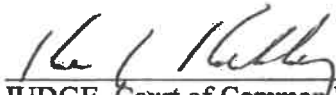
Any and all medical records from February 24, 2026 for an adult male known as **RICARDO DAVIS (DOB: 10-6-1996)** including, but not limited to, narrative summary, aftercare service plan, psychiatric examination, history and physical, psychology evaluation, social work assessment, progress notes, lab results, treatment plans, consultation, orders, and other records relevant to the patient's care, and any other information that tends to establish a violation of the laws of the State of Ohio, to wit: Felonious Assault in violation of 2903.11.

I am satisfied that there is probable cause to believe the property described is being maintained within the above-described premises and that grounds for issuance of this search warrant exist.

THEREFORE: You are hereby commanded in the name of the State of Ohio, with the necessary and proper assistance, to serve this warrant and search forthwith for the property specified, and if the property specified or any part thereof be found there, you are commanded to seize it, leaving a copy of this warrant and a receipt for the property taken, to prepare a written inventory of the property seized, to return this warrant to the undersigned or any Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, Cuyahoga County, and to bring the property found on such search

forthwith before said Judge, or some other judge or magistrate of the county having cognizance thereof.

**AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH
WARRANT**

Before me, a Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, Summit County, Ohio, personally appeared the undersigned Special Agent Joseph Goudy, badge #83 of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation and being first duly sworn states his training and experience include the following: approximately twenty-five years as a law enforcement officer; approximately four and a half years as a Special Agent with the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation's Force Investigation's Unit. The past fourteen years with the Cuyahoga County Sheriff's Department, four years of which he has been a Detective with the department's Detective Bureau and previous five years as a Detective in the department's Impact Unit; training in various investigations, particularly Officer Involved Critical Incident investigations, economic crimes and general criminal investigations; prior training in the recognition and detection of controlled substances and their methods of production and distribution through his basic police training course with the University of Akron Police Academy; advanced training in the areas of traffic enforcement and drug interdiction from the Ohio Peace Officer's Training Academy along with advanced training in various economic fraud investigations and money laundering related crimes; and directed and/or participated in numerous illicit drug trafficking operations, which were resultant in state prosecutions. These investigations have resulted in numerous arrests and convictions in Federal State and Local Jurisdictions. Your affiant also possesses an Associates Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Akron and a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from Tiffin University.

Affiant avers that he believes and has good cause to believe that within the premises knows as Metro Health Hospital, located at 2500 Metro Health Drive, Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, and further described as a health care provider facility/hospital, there is now being kept, concealed and possessed the following evidence of a criminal offense:

Any and all medical records from February 24, 2026 for an adult male known as **RICARDO DAVIS** (DOB: 10-6-1996) including, but not limited to, narrative summary, aftercare service plan, psychiatric examination, history and physical, psychology evaluation,

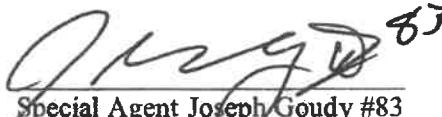
social work assessment, progress notes, lab results, treatment plans, consultation, orders, and other records relevant to the patient's care, and any other information that tends to establish a violation of the laws of the State of Ohio, to wit: Felonious Assault in violation of 2903.11.

The facts upon which affiant bases such beliefs are as follows:

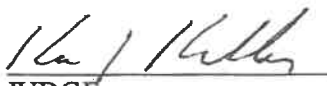
1. On Tuesday, February 24, 2026, the Brooklyn Police Department (BPD) requested the assistance of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations (BCI) to investigate an officer-involved shooting involving officers from the Parma Police Department.
2. The affiant avers that on February 24, 2026, Parma Police Officers were dispatched to a welfare check at 5433 Knollwood Drive #8 in Parma, Ohio for a suicidal male identified as Ricardo Yuuki Davis (Davis).
3. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department received information from Davis's friend, Henry Sieaaniec, that Davis was suicidal. Parma Police reported that Davis called Sieaaniec and said, "Goodbye."
4. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department responded to 5433 Knollwood Drive #8, in Parma to check on Davis's welfare.
5. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department gained entry into Davis's apartment. Once inside the apartment, multiple notes were observed where items were labeled to go to certain members of Davis's family. It was also reported that Davis left information about a death certificate.
6. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department found receipts inside of Davis's apartment for a Taurus handgun purchased at the Parma Armory, located at 5301 Hauserman Road, in Parma, Ohio.
7. The affiant avers that Parma Police Officers located Davis near the intersection of Brookpark Road and Hauserman Road, driving a red 2015 Toyota Corolla bearing Ohio registration JSF3645
8. The affiant avers that while Davis was driving away from the Parma Police Officers, he was observed reaching into his back seat allegedly for his handgun.
9. The affiant avers that Davis eventually stopped his vehicle on Brookpark Road (westbound) in front of the IHOP restaurant (10810 Brookpark Road, Brooklyn, Ohio).
10. The affiant avers that after Davis stopped; he exited his vehicle and walked rapidly towards the Parma Police Officers.
11. The affiant avers that Davis allegedly had a gun on his person as he rapidly walked towards the Parma Police Officers which resulted in several gunshots being fired.

12. The affiant avers that Davis sustained multiple gunshot wounds. Additionally, a Parma Police vehicle was found to be struck by gunfire.
13. The affiant avers that emergency medical aid was provided to Davis before he was eventually transported to the Metro Health Hospital, 2500 Metro Health Drive, Cleveland, Ohio, where he was later pronounced deceased.
14. The affiant avers that while processing the scene and searching Davis's vehicle, a suicide note was discovered on the door of Davis's apartment. A second suicide note, along with a rope and a ladder, was also found inside Davis's vehicle.
15. Based on your Affiant's training and experience, obtaining Ricardo Davis's medical records from Metro Health Hospital would be valuable in determining the extent of his injuries, any substances he might have been under the influence of, and any statement he made during treatment.
16. Affiant avers this search warrant is necessary since Ohio law precludes law enforcement from obtaining such records by grand jury subpoena pursuant to *Turk v. Oiler*, 732 F.Supp.2d 758, 2010 WL 3211680 (August 11, 2010, N.D. Ohio).
