APPROVAL—WATER LEASE, SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC WORKS WITH F. W. WORK, AKRON, OHIO, TERM FIVE YEARS, ANNUAL RENTAL \$60.00, RIGHT TO USE WATER FROM LONG LAKE UNDER TERMS OUTLINED.

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of your communication with which you submit for my examination and approval a certain water lease in triplicate in and by which the State of Ohio, acting through you as Superintendent of Public Works, has given and granted to one F. W. Work of Akron, Ohio, the right to insert a two-inch pipe into the level of Long Lake in the westerly embankment thereof and to take water therefrom for sprinkling purposes for a period of five years from May 1, 1938, subject to the provision that water shall be taken for this purpose only during the months of May, June, July, August, September and October of each year during the term of the lease.

Upon examination of the lease, which provides for the payment of an annual rental of sixty dollars for the use of the water therein and thereby provided for, I find that this lease is one which you are authorized to execute under the provisions of Section 14009, General Code. I further find on examination of the lease that the same has been properly executed by you as Superintendent of Public Works and by F. W. Work, the lessee therein named, and that the provisions of this lease and the conditions and restrictions therein contained are in conformity with the provisions of the General Code above referred to and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind. I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
