Narrative:

On August 30, 2024, the Licking County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) requested the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) investigate an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) at 4206 Northridge Road, Alexandria, Ohio, involving officers with the LCSO, the Johnstown Police Department (JPD), and Doug Plott (Plott). Plott was ultimately shot by responding officers and succumbed to his injuries.

There were three initial responding officers. LCSO were identified as officers discharging their firearms during the incident with LCSO Deputy Nicholas Dewitt (Deputy Dewitt) being witness to the incident.

Deputy Kevin Williams (Deputy Williams) was identified as an officer responding after the shooting incident and assisting with medical aid. Deputy Williams prepared a written incident report, which was provided to BCI through his legal counsel Attorney Bob Sauter on September 9, 2024.

Deputy Williams wrote the following:

"On August 30, 2024, at 0924 hours, I was dispatched to 4206 Northridge Road on a report of a physical domestic violence incident.

When I arrived on scene, I located Sergeant Snodgrass and Deputy Dewitt in the rear of the above address. Sergeant Snodgrass advised me to being chest compressions on the suspect that was lying supine on the ground in the rear of the residence. I began chest compression and continued them until I was relieved by Deputy Dewitt.

EMS personnel arrived on scene and began treatment on the suspect. The EMS personnel did

pronounce the suspect deceased at the scene.

I was advised to return to the Licking County Sheriff's office for an incident debrief."
