Narrative:

On Monday, October 14, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber), received the Wadsworth Fire and EMS run report from Medina County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) Captain Kris Conwill (Conwill). The report was associated with the October 5, 2024, emergency response regarding David Michael Septer (Septer).

SA Joseph Goudy (Goudy) reviewed the report and noted the following:

The report indicated that Wadsworth medic four was dispatched to 10430 Silver Creek Road for a male with gunshot wounds. The male was identified as David Michael Septer (Septer). After emergency life saving measures were taken, Septer was eventually pronounced deceased while on scene by Doctor Nesheim at 2230 hours.


