SYNOPSIS:

- > On Thursday, June 2, 2022 at 1734 hours, CCS advised Fourth District Officers that a male was shot at 3495 East 98th Street #703.
- > As the Officers were enroute they received additional information that Officers from the CMHA Police Department were involved in a Use of Deadly Force.
- > EMS Medic 7 arrived and transported the suspect to U.H. where Dr. Rushing pronounced him deceased at 1818 hours.
- > EMS Medic 28 arrived and transported P.O. to U.H. where he was confined.
- > A full FIT call up was initiated and members of the FIT responded to both the scene and hospital.
- > Homicide Unit, Internal Affairs, and Crime Scene responded.
- > Several interviews were conducted on scene by members of the FIT.
- > CSRU, Sgt. Rini, Detectives Emerick, Hale and Edge processed the scene.
- > Preliminary investigation reveals that CMHA P.D. Officers responded to 3495 East 98th Street #703 c/w a Disturbance with a male throwing items from a 7th floor balcony down into the street.
- > CMHA P.D. P.O. and SGT. observed several items on the grass and in the street. These items included a bedframe, a closet door, a broken mirror, a cellphone, a hatchet, a floor lamp, 2 chairs, a fan, 5 gallon buckets, several cans of food, and a big screen television.
- > The Officers entered the building, took the elevator to the 7th floor, approached the entrance to apartment 703, and knocked on the door.
- > The Officers entered the apartment, announced "POLICE DEPARTMENT" and observed the entire apartment in disarray. There were items thrown all around and water that was covering the floor. There was also blood present on a closet door.
- > The Officers heard running water and approached the source of the running water; a bathroom connected to a bedroom.
- > Here they encountered DEMOND ESKRIDGE, who was sitting in a bathtub with the water running and the water was overflowing the side of the tub.
- ESKRIDGE stood up out of the tub and asked "do we got a problem?" as he approached P.O. as PO was backing out of the bedroom.
- ESKRIDGE approached P.O. and punched P.O. in the face. SGT grabbed ahold of ESKRIDGE'S left arm and ESKRIDGE grabbed and took possession of P.O. weapon, a 9mm Glock handgun.
- > P.O. attempted to get his gun back and ESKRIDGE began biting P.O. left hand.
- > P.O. used his right hand to attempt to dislodge his left hand from ESKRIDGE'S mouth and alerted SGT that that "he has my gun".
- > SGT deployed his issued Taser striking ESKRIDGE.
- > ESKRIDGE pointed the weapon (that he stole from PO missing his head.
- > At some point as PO was attempting to get his finger out of ESKRIDGE'S mouth and get his
