Re: Bonds of Stokes township, Logan county, in the amount of \$7,500 in anticipation of the collection of taxes and assessments for the improvement of Carpenter road.

Gentlemen:—The bonds under consideration were issued under authority of section 3298-15e G. C. in anticipation of the collection of taxes and special assessments for the improvement of Carpenter road and bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually.

From an examination of the transcript it appears that the resolution of the township trustees declaring the necessity of said road improvement was adopted November 28, 1919. This was the first essential step in the proceedings leading up to the improvement and the issuance of the bonds under consideration. At the date of the adoption of this resolution the township trustees were authorized by section 3298-15e G. C. to issue bonds in anticipation of the collection of taxes and special assessments for road improvements bearing interest at a rate not exceeding five per cent per annum. Subsequent to that date said section 3298-15e was amended so that bonds issued thereunder might bear interest at not to exceed six per cent per annum. This amendment, found
