Narrative:

On Tuesday, March 17, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Douglas Burke (Burke) received the "Firearms Trace Summary" report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm which Ricardo Yuuki Davis (Ricardo) possessed during the Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) on Tuesday, February 24, 2026. The report provided details about the Taurus, model G2C, serial number AEH630415, including that it was purchased by Ricardo on October 13, 2025. The firearm was [REDACTED]

Additionally, an FBI National Crime Information (NCIC) check of the weapon was conducted by the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit to determine if the weapon was reported as being stolen.
