Narrative:

On the morning of September 10, 2024, an Officer-Involved Critical Incident took place outside the Columbus Police Precinct 4 Substation. Six Columbus Police officers encountered an armed subject, Lamine Mahmoudi, who died from injuries he sustained.

On October 9, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) James Gore queried the online Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (OPOTC) database for the certification status of each of the involved officers. The database maintains public records regarding appointment dates, separation dates, Ohio basic peace officer certification, and advanced training courses that were scheduled through the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA). The database is not reflective of any training that the officers may have received through their employing agency, from other organizations, or from out-of-state entities.
