Background Information

OOCIC synchronized three videos on one screen for the presentation. The videos were from the following sources:

1. Surveillance video from the Duke and Duchess Gas Station located at 2215 East Avenue, Akron, Ohio.
2. Akron Police Department (APD) [REDACTED] body-worn camera (BWC).
3. Akron Police Department (APD) [REDACTED] body-worn camera (BWC).

OOCIC also added frame counters in the lower left portions of each video screen, two audio waveform bars underneath the video screens of [REDACTED] BWC video and [REDACTED] BWC video, a timecode effect in the upper right portion of the screen, and an indication that the video file was playing at 60 frames per second (FPS).

These videos were from an incident that occurred on August 17, 2024, involving a male subject, Michael Jones (Jones), [REDACTED] that resulted in an officer-involved critical incident (shooting).

4. Amped Replay bookmarked images.
5. Amped Replay report.
6. Timing and Action Summary Spreadsheet.

Timing and Action Summary Spreadsheet – Process and Documentation

As part of this in-depth video review, SAS Moran created a “Timing and Action Summary” spreadsheet documenting many of the significant events noted during the video review.

SAS Moran used the spreadsheet to count the frames between select bookmarked image frames to determine approximately how much time elapsed between certain actions and events.

SAS Moran used the formula, =COUNTA(COLUMN LETTER BEGINNING ROW NUMBER:SAME COLUMN LETTER END ROW NUMBER) to calculate the number of frames between select bookmarked image frames. SAS Moran multiplied the total number of frames in the columns by 0.016666666666667 (1/60th of a second) to determine the approximate elapsed time between select bookmarked image frames.

The calculated approximate elapsed time was rounded up or down to the nearest hundredth place decimal to make it easier to comprehend. For example:

- 23 frames multiplied by 0.016666666666667 equaled 0.383333333333333 of a second. This number was rounded to 0.38 of a second.

Video Review Process

SAS Moran located the video file on the BCI Special Investigations Unit (SIU) shared drive in the Reference Item G folder. It was labeled:

- **24-00112_SPEED_VIEWS_SEGMENT**

SAS Moran made a working copy of the video file and placed it in a folder on his BCI-issued laptop. The working copy of the video was used for this review.

SAS Moran imported the video file into Amped Replay for review.

SAS Moran bookmarked images for demonstrative purposes. The bookmarked images were selected based upon the best available visual and audio cues. SAS Moran also created a "Derivatives" folder for any bookmarked images that were generated by Amped Replay. The bookmarked images were placed in the "Derivatives - Activity Review" folder.

SAS Moran generated an Amped Replay report for the review. SAS Moran also created a "Report" folder for any report(s) generated by Amped Replay. The review report was placed in the "Report - Activity Review" folder.

All of these items can be located in the Reference Item G folder.

The original surveillance video file, the original BWC video files, and the OOCIC work product video file(s) should be viewed and evaluated independently of any derivative(s) from the Amped Replay review.

Additional Activity Summary

Another relevant factor to consider is the distance that Jones drove the truck while [REDACTED] were on the exterior driver's side. Jones drove the truck from the parking lot near the middle gas pumps, north on East Avenue, and the truck eventually stopped on East Avenue (near the northernmost gas pumps). This was approximately 215 feet.

SAS Moran used Amped Replay and cropped several of the bookmarked images from Amped Replay derivatives from the review of the OOCIC synchronized video presentation. The cropped area focused on the surveillance video portion of the screen. SAS Moran added yellow lines to the cropped images (concrete lines, center areas of gas pumps) and aqua lines to the cropped images (lines of the U-Haul truck) to help illustrate the movement of the truck throughout the area. SAS Moran also added text to the images to provide context of what was occurring in the synchronized video presentation. The cropped and annotated images were placed in the "Derivates - Crop Annotate" folder.

Amped Replay reports were generated for each cropped and annotated image. The reports were placed in the "Reports - Crop Annotate" folder.

Overhead Diagram with Measurements

SAS Moran contacted BCI Crime Scene Technician (CST) Mike Rostocil and inquired about the Leica BLK360 3D scan data for the incident. SAS Moran asked CST Rostocil to view the OOCIC synchronized video presentation and the cropped and annotated images above and compare them with the scan data to determine an approximate distance that the U-Haul truck traveled during significant times during the incident. SAS Moran emailed CST Rostocil the OOCIC synchronized video presentation and the cropped and annotated images through Kiteworks.

CST Rostocil performed the review and 3D scan data analysis and completed a report. See BCI investigative report titled, ***"2025-02-28: Overhead Diagram with Measurements"*** for details. Below is some information derived from that report:

Measurement 1 was from the front end of the approximate starting position of the U-Haul truck parked at the gas pump of the Duchess Shoppe to the approximate center line of the South end driveway leading to East Avenue, which was found to be approximately 33 feet.

Measurement 2 was from the end of measurement 1 to the approximate center of the Northbound lane of East Avenue, which was found to be approximately 38 feet.

Measurement 3 was from the end of measurement 2 to the approximate location of the possible shooting incident in the Northbound lane of East Avenue, which was found to be approximately 50 feet.

Measurement 4 was from the end of measurement 3 to the front end of the truck in its final resting position, which was found to be approximately 96 feet.

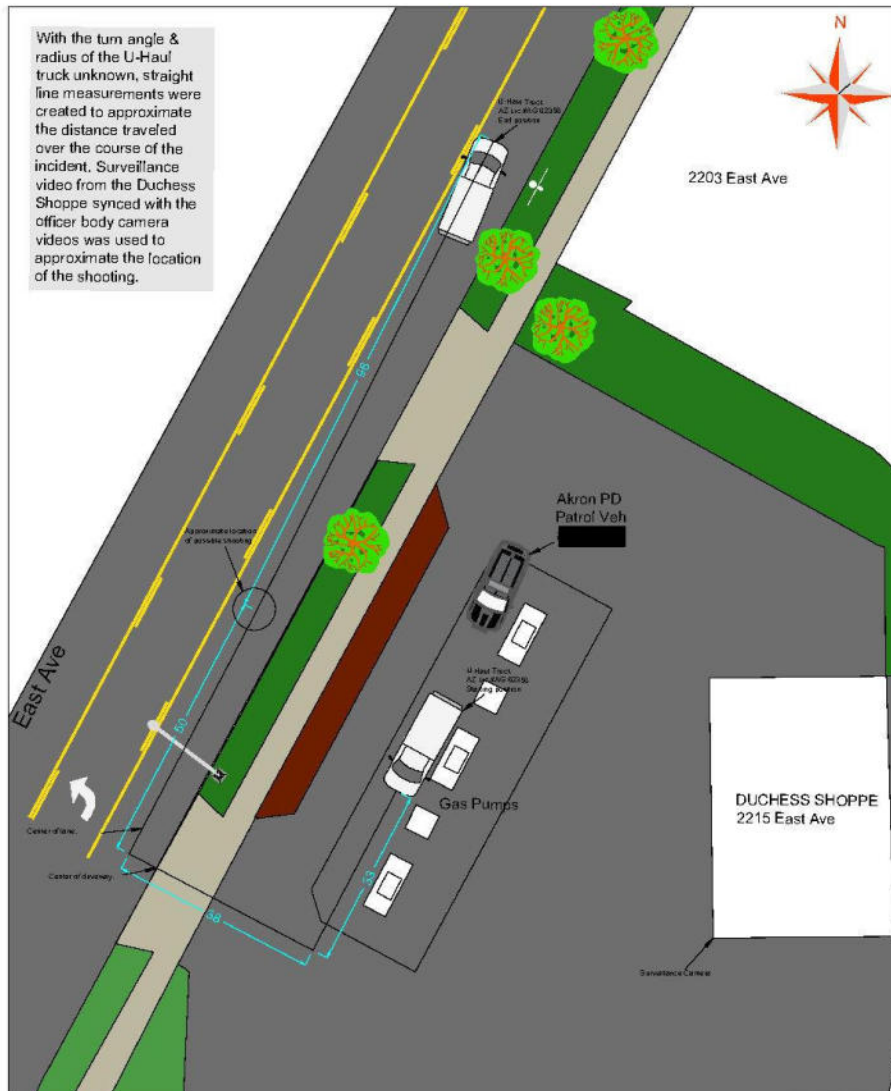

Additional Factors to Consider When Evaluating Digital Multimedia Evidence (DME)

Based upon SAS Moran's training and experience, the following factors should be considered when evaluating the available video evidence:

- The speed of this incident is remarkable.
- The speed and complexity of rapidly evolving situation(s) that occur during use-of-force encounters are difficult concepts to comprehend by only watching the video.
- Video and audio recording devices record more information about a particular scene or incident than the person(s) involved in the event can process during the critical incident.
- Video and audio recording devices rarely record an event from the same perspective of the officer(s) or subject(s) involved.
- It captures the action but not the perception, decision-making, focus nor intent of the officer(s).
- Video recordings often miss tactile cues or other actions of a subject.
- Video and audio recording devices record within the video and sound capabilities available, and they record objectively.
- Video and audio recordings lack the history, perspective and interest of the people involved.
- The movements, positions, angles, obstacles, lighting, and distance from the incident are also factors that need serious consideration.
- Video recordings are for storage and review.
- Video recordings capture light and create a digital representation of reality (two-dimensional video compared to three-dimensional reality).
- Video and audio recordings are only components of an investigation and should not be the only evidence relied upon.
- All available evidence, statements and other information must be evaluated alongside the video recordings available.
