**Narrative:**

On May 27, 2025, at 1019 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Lauren Frazier and Douglas Eveslage interviewed Aubree Baker, the daughter of Michael Baker. Also present was Tammy Layman, Aubree's maternal grandmother. The interview took place outside near 909 Garden Avenue in Middletown, Ohio. The purpose of the interview was to make sure the next of kin was aware of Michael Baker's death and to obtain all relevant information regarding the incident.

The following summary of the recorded interview highlights the key points that the author deemed most relevant, although it does not provide a verbatim account. Additionally, this report was placed in a chronology to enhance the reader's understanding of the information elicited during the interview. However, it is important to note that this may not reflect the actual order of the questions posed. Therefore, it is suggested that the full audio recording be reviewed.

Aubree said that she lives at 909 Garden Avenue with her father, Michael Baker, and Mary Dunn. She said that Michael and Mary have been in an on and off relationship for a few months. Aubree said that Mary has been living at the house since December of 2024. She said that her dad has lived at the residence for over a year. Aubree said that she recently moved back in a couple of weeks ago.

Aubree said that her dad drives a silver sedan, which was parked right in front of their house. She said it's registered in her name, but that it's her dad's car. Aubree said that her dad dropped her off at work around 6:45am this morning. She works at BMF Devices in Miamisburg as an operator. Tammy said it's a family company and she is the Plant Manager.

Around 7:45am, Aubree stated that she received several calls from her neighbors telling her that two people were shot at her house and that police had a search warrant. One neighbor, "TV" asked Aubree if she was okay. Aubree said that she was at work and didn't know

anything about what happened. Aubree saw a Fox19 News article that someone had passed and another person was shot at her address. Tammy said that she took Aubree to Atrium Hospital and they weren't able to get any information, so they came to the the house.

Aubree told agents that she heard that her dad answered the door with a gun. She said that the only reason he would do that is because Aubree's ex-boyfriend lives nearby, is violent, and has robbed the house before. Aubree said that she knows her father to have a gun for "safety purposes." She said that he keeps it under his bed or in his closet. She said that it's a silver gun but did not know any other details.

Tammy said that Michael is not aggressive and he is very timid. Aubree said that there are other people that frequent the house and have keys to the house. One is named "Squeak" Watkins, described as a White male in his mid 40's, bald, with tattoos. Aubree said that Squeak is Mary's cousin and he drives a newer black GMC truck. A White male named Joey usually hangs around with Squeak. Aubree said that they would hang out and smoke marijuana.

Aubree's brother is Taylor Baker. She called and spoke briefly on the phone with Taylor, who said that he was already aware that their father had passed. Agents asked Aubree if she knew why police would be serving a search warrant at the house. Aubree said that her dad was not into drugs and believed that Mary, and the people she knew, were the possible target.

Aubree said that there was a camera inside the house but it has been unplugged. The interview concluded at 1043 hours. A copy of the audio recorded interview is attached.
