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Summary

On 06/07/2026, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation's (BCI) Cyber Crimes Unit (CCU) was requested by the West Chester Police Department and the BCI Force Investigations Unit to assist in the investigation of an Officer Involved Critical Incident, pursuant to signed consent.

Submitted Items:

001 CCU# 2 CSU# – Mobile Phone – Gold Apple iPhone

002 CCU # 003 CSU# – Mobile Phone – Gold Apple iPhone 16 Pro Max A3084

Details

Item #001: The gold iPhone in a clear case was submitted without the proper legal authority to search the device. The cell phone was not removed from the evidence bag. Special Agent Joshua Welty of the BCI Force Investigations Unit stated they do not intend to seek a search warrant or further processing of the device. No extraction was performed on the gold iPhone in a clear case.

Item #002: The gold Apple iPhone 16 Pro Max (A3084) cell phone in a pink case was received powered off. The cell phone is an eSIM only device. The cell phone was powered on inside a Faraday box. The cell phone was already in Airplane mode. The cell phone was connected to GrayKey. GrayKey is a forensic tool capable of bypassing certain security restrictions, determining passcodes, and extracting data from devices. The passcode [REDACTED] provided by the case investigator was used to unlock the device. A Full File System extraction was performed with GrayKey. The cell phone extraction was processed with Cellebrite Physical Analyzer.

Conclusions

Item #001: No extraction was performed on the gold Apple iPhone in a clear case.

Item #002: Data was extracted from the gold Apple iPhone 16 Pro Max (A3084) cell phone. All

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data from the Full File System extraction from the gold Apple iPhone 16 Pro Max (A3084) cell phone is provided for review with Cellebrite Reader.

Attachment

The folder "002 - Apple iPhone 16 Pro Max" contains the Cellebrite Reader program and the report package of data that was extracted from the cell phone. Double-click "CellebriteReader.exe" to open the application. Allow a few seconds for the data to begin loading indicated by a green status bar in the bottom right corner. If the parsed data is not loaded automatically then click Open from the File menu, browse to this folder, and choose "002 - Apple iPhone 16 Pro Max Report" to view the data that was processed from the cell phone.

The "Evidence Pictures" folder contains pictures of the cell phones.
