**Narrative:**

On 11/13/2025 at 1130 hours, Special Agent David Hammond submitted the following items of evidence to the BCI Bowling Green Lab for testing.

Item 8 – Daisy Phantom BB / Pellet Handgun located at the scene.

Coroner's Item 5: DNA Blood Card from Robert Norton.

Special Agent Doug Burke had previously contacted S/A Hammond regarding this case. The Hancock County Prosecutor's Office contacted S/A Burke requesting that the Daisy Phantom BB gun be tested for the subject's DNA.

S/A Burke advised S/A Hammond that the DNA supervisor in London was consulted and authorized the testing to assist with the case. The items were retrieved from the Non-Drug Evidence Room and submitted to the laboratory.

No other requests have been made of the BCI Crime Scene Unit in this matter. The Crime Scene Unit portion of the investigation should be considered closed.
