Narrative:

On Tuesday, March 3, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Douglas Burke (Burke) received a request from Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office Chief Investigator Justin Wilson for a snippet of a Dash Cam Video involving the Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) on February 24, 2026, at 10810 Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH which involved Parma Police Department (PPD).

SA Burke and SA Dan Boerner (Boerner) reviewed the Axon Fleet 3 Front Dash Cam from PPD Cruiser #169 which had been operated by Witness Officer (Ofc.), Chris Smith (Chris). The snippet started on February 24, 2026, at 13:41:09 and ended at 13:41:35. This snippet showed the involved subject, Ricardo Yuuki Davis (Ricardo), exiting his vehicle with a firearm in his right hand, held in a downward position, and approaching officers. Two (2) officers from PPD discharged their duty issued weapons towards Ricardo.

Ricardo immediately fell to the ground and succumbed to his injuries.

This snippet was then emailed to Chief Investigator Justin Wilson from the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office for his investigation by SA Boerner. The snippet footage was submitted and placed into Axon Justice, Reference Item E-Parma PD Dash Cam > Sub Folder, Screen Recording for Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner.
