DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a communication from the chief of the bureau of inland lakes and parks of the division of conservation in your department requesting my approval of a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the conservation commissioner to one J. O. Morgan of Columbus, Ohio.

By the lease under consideration there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to use and occupy for cottage site and docklanding purposes the inner slope and water front and the outer slope and barrow pits adjacent thereto that are included in the north half of lot No. 85 west of the waste gates at Buckeye Lake.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the conservation commissioner and by the lessee; and that the terms and provisions of this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years, and providing for an annual rental of twenty-four dollars (\$24.00) are in conformity with the statutory provisions of this State relating to leases of this kind.
