Narrative:

On Thursday, June 4, 2026, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by the West Chester Police Department (WCPD) to investigate an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that occurred at 9093 Zinnia Court Apt 1209, West Chester Ohio, Ohio, 45069. The incident resulted in the death of the subject, Lorenzo Miller (Miller).

Ohio BCI Special Agent Kevin Barkley (SA Barkley) responded to the West Chester Police Department (WCPD), located at 9577 Beckett Road, Suite 500, West Chester, OH 45069, in order to document the involved officer, [REDACTED].

On June 5, 2026, at 0107 hours, SA Barkley photographed the front, back and both sides of WCPD [REDACTED] Badge # [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was dressed in his WCPD patrol uniform that consisted of a dark navy long sleeve shirt with WCPD patches on both shoulders, an external ballistic vest, a WCPD badge, name tag, and navy pants. SA Barkley documented [REDACTED] duty weapon, a Sig Sauer, P320 pistol with serial number [REDACTED]. The pistol had a Holsun red dot optic and a Streamlight TRL-1 tactical light. SA Barkley removed one cartridge from the chamber, and the seated magazine contained 16 cartridges. [REDACTED] spare magazines were photographed for documentation only.

All photographs taken have been uploaded and stored in Axon (see references). SA Barkley transferred the firearm to BCI Crime Scene Technician (CST) Holly Ryczek at WCPD.
