**Narrative:**

On Tuesday, December 10, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (SA Harasimchuk) received and reviewed the "Firearms Trace Summary" reports related to this case from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The reports contained information about the firearms that James Vanest (Vanest) possessed during the incident on November 18, 2024.

The ATF Trace Summary report # [REDACTED] provided details about the Ruger, model LCR, 38 caliber revolver, serial number 540-45090, including that it was purchased by [REDACTED].

The ATF Trace Summary report # [REDACTED] provided details about the HS Produkt (IM Metal), model XDM, 10 caliber pistol, serial number BE277600, including that it was purchased by [REDACTED].

The ATF Trace Summary report # [REDACTED] provided details about the Romarm/Cugir, model WASR-10, 762 caliber rifle, serial number A1-33596-15. This firearm was traced [REDACTED].

The ATF Trace Summary report # [REDACTED] provided details about the Dikar, rifle, serial number 61-06-133257-23, including that it was purchased by [REDACTED].

The ATF Trace Summary report # [REDACTED] provided details about the Dikar rifle, serial number 204216591. The ATF Trace report stated the following:
