APPROVAL—CONTRACT STATE OF OHIO BY DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS WITH CITY OF CINCINNATI, OHIO, PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT, STATE HIGHWAY No. 43, SECTION CINCINNATI (PART) HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, U.S.W.P.G.C. AND PORJECT No. W.P.G.M. 539-E.

John Jaster, Jr., Director, Department of Highway, Columbus, DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval as to legality and form a certain contract in duplicate by and between the City of Cincinnati and the State of Ohio, acting by the Ohio Director of Highways covering a certain proposed improvement described and design nated as State-Highway No. 43, Section Cincinnati (Part) Hamilton County, Ohio, and further known and designated as U.S.W.P.G.C. Project No. W.P.G.M. 539-E (1936). Attached thereto is the certificate of the acting auditor of the Department of Highways certifying that the funds are available for the payment of all the cost of the project from an advance of Federal funds deposited in the State Treasury in a trust account being from an appropriation made to the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Public Roads, There is also atatached the certificate of the city auditor of Cincinnati, Ohio, certifying that the money required for the payment of the cost thereof other than that part assumed by the State, of said improvement, is in the Treasury or in the process of collection and not appropriated for any other purpose.

Upon examination, I find said contract in duplicate correct as to legality and form and that the same will be a valid contract when executed by the Director of Highways for and on behalf of the State of Ohio and I have, therefore, endorsed by approval thereon and am returning the same herewith.
