On August 28, 2023, Special Agent (SA) Mathew Austin met with Crime Scene Technician (CST) Amy Gill at BCI at approximately 1100 hours. CST Gill provided SA Austin with a paper bag containing multiple items of evidence from the autopsy of Ta'kiya Young and a printed copy of an inventory.

SA Austin documented these items through photography and the packaged items as follows:

Item 1: Bullet from T-10 spine w/ fragment from L breast surface

Item 2: Ink cards, FTA card, photographs on CD, and multiple pieces of jewelry

SA Austin then retrieved the previously secured items from scenes 1-3 and packaged the items from the drying cabinet. The following items were then submitted to the laboratory:

Item 1 (scene 1): Hornady 9mm Luger +P casing

Item 1 (scene 3): Glock 17 9mm handgun (s/n

Item 1 (scene 4): Bullet recovered from the autopsy of Young

All other items were submitted to the #2 London evidence locker for storage.
