Gentlemen:—

I have examined the transcript for the foregoing issue of bonds and find that I cannot approve the same for the reason that the affidavit of the publisher shows that these bonds have been advertised for sale on September 19th, 26th, October 3rd and 10th, 1924, and the notice as published provided for the sale of bonds on October 14th, 1924.

This conclusion is based upon the case of State of Ohio vs. Kuhner and King, 107 O. S., page 406, in which the court held:

"The requirement of Section 1206, General Code, that 'the state highway commissioner shall advertise for bids for two consecutive weeks,' is mandatory, and the contract entered on June 14 for advertisement in two weekly newspapers of the county on June 6th and June 13th is invalid."

For the reason that the foregoing issue of bonds has not been advertised the proper length of time, as required by the statute, you are advised not to purchase the same.
