**Narrative:**

On May 23, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Craig Call (SA Call) and Ryan Scheiderer (SA Scheiderer) interviewed Madison County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) [REDACTED] in reference to his involvement in the May 12, 2024 Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) near Georgesville Road and Clime Road, Columbus, Ohio. [REDACTED] identified himself as a [REDACTED] with the Franklin County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) [REDACTED]. Refer to report 2024-05-23 [REDACTED] [REDACTED] completed by SA Scheiderer for information associated with the interview.

During the interview, [REDACTED] referenced contacting his [REDACTED] Supervisor Sergeant Jake Smith (Sgt. Smith) to inform him of the shooting incident at the Amazon facility located in Madison County and the identity of the involved subject Hamsa Y. Ali.

SA Call made contact with Sgt. Smith on a later date and was provided the following written statement detailing the contact between [REDACTED] and Sgt. Smith on May 12, 2024:

*"On May 12, 2024, Sergeant Smith with the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was contacted by [REDACTED] with the Madison County Sheriffs Office regarding a shooting 5"that occurred at Amazon in Madison County, Ohio. It should be noted, [REDACTED] is also currently assigned as a [REDACTED]."*

*Upon being notified regarding the shooting at Amazon, Sergeant Smith was informed the suspect, later identified as Hamsa Yusuf ALI, had left the area of Amazon and possibly was traveling to Columbus (Ohio).*

*[REDACTED] provided Sergeant Smith with ALI's name and date of birth as well as a description of the vehicle used to leave Amazon. The description of the vehicle provided to*

*Sergeant Smith conducted searches on individuals associated with this address through the law enforcement database in an attempt to locate information pertaining to the Toyota Camry. During the search, Sergeant Smith identified Yusf ALI as the registered owner of a white Toyota Camry bearing Ohio registration JNJ-3078 which had a listed address of 5228 Deignese Place.
