On June 18, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb was assigned to assist the Warren County Sheriff's Office and the Lebanon Police Department with an officer involved critical incident. It was reported that an officer and a deputy shot Dione Kellum (Kellum) after he brandished a firearm and discharged it. After he was presumably shot by law enforcement, it is believed that Kellum shot himself, committing suicide. He was later transported to the Montgomery County Coroner's Office for an autopsy.

On June 26, 2023, at 0903 hours, SA Holcomb retrieved a bag containing two projectiles that were recovered from autopsy from the BCI major crimes evidence vault. The projectiles were packaged and labeled as item #1. At 0918 hours, SA Holcomb submitted the projectiles to the BCI laboratory for examination.
