Dear Sir:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the state of Ohio, acting by the department of highways and public works, and Johns-Manville, Inc., a foreign corporation whose Ohio address is Euclid Ave. and 46th St., Cleveland, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of "removing the present base and floor finish in the corridors of science hall, Kent state normal school, Kent, Ohio, and replacing them with mastic flooring," and calls for an expenditure of \$5,100.00.

You have submitted the certificate of the director of finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract. There has further been submitted a contract bond upon which the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Company appears as surety, sufficient to cover the amount of the contract.
