APPROVAL, DEEDS TO LAND IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP, JACKSON COUNTY, OHIO, EXECUTED BY STANLEY DRAKE AND NORA DRAKE: AND O. C. COOPER AND MINNIE COOPER.

Gentlemen:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of your recent communication, with which you submit for my examination and approval three Warranty Deeds, executed by Stanley Drake and Nora Drake, his wife, O. C. Cooper and Minnie Cooper, his wife, and Wilder G. Ray, a widower, conveying to The Ohio State Archaeological and Historical Society, three small parcels of land in Jackson Township, Jackson County, Ohio. I am advised by your communication, that these parcels of land are being secured by your society as additions to the Cooper Petroglyph State Park in said township and county.

It seems quite clear that under the provisions of Section 10198-1, General Code, you are authorized to acquire the lands now comprised within the park above referred to; and under the provisions of this section as amended in House Bill No. 277, enacted by the 90th General Assembly, 115 O. L. 207, you are just as clearly authorized to acquire the parcels of land here in question as additions to this park.

Upon examination of these deeds, I find that the same have been properly executed and acknowledged by the respective grantors therein and that the form of these deeds is such; that the same are legally sufficient to convey the respective parcels of land therein described to the Ohio State Archaeological and Historical Society by fee simple title, free and clear of all dower and other outstanding interests and free and clear of all encumbrances whatsoever.

No abstracts of title were submitted with these deeds and I am not passing upon the title of these several grantors to the lands conveyed by these deeds. However, finding that these deeds have been properly executed and that they are in proper form, I am herewith approving these deeds as is evidenced by my approval endorsed thereon.
