Narrative:

On Friday, October 25, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Special Agent Steven Seitzman received Montgomery County Sheriff's Office Seitzman MCSO Sergeant Isaiah Keller.

SA Seitzman reviewed the footage and noted the following:

- According to the timestamp, arrived at the scene at approximately 0850 hours.
- He eventually moved up to a marked Dayton Police Dodge Charger, where a Dayton police officer was. At approximately 0854 hours, he positioned himself at the right rear of the cruiser, where he remained for the remainder of the incident.
- At approximately 0909 hours, quickly crouched down, then repositioned himself and fired what appeared to be five rounds over the course of approximately two seconds [Approximately frames 33552–33612 at 29.97 fps.]
- moved up toward the involved tan Buick with other law enforcement officers. He then appears to assist with clearing the vehicle.
- deactivated his camera at approximately 0914 hours.

This report does not contain all of SA Seitzman's observations from state state s body-worn camera, as much of the events were detailed during the review of other body-worn and cruiser camera footage.

The body-camera footage was saved in the AGO Network BCI_Data F: Drive.
