On Monday, October 14, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received the personnel file and training records for [REDACTED] from the Medina County Sheriff's Office (MCSO). SA Lieber reviewed the personnel file and training records and noted the following:
