Narrative:

On Tuesday, March 03, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Douglas Burke (SA Burke) received dash camera video footage from Lieutenant (Lt.) Pat Suchan from the Parma Police Department (PPD). SA Burke was informed that the videos contained footage were from the dash cameras recorded by the PPD. On March 12, 2026, SA Burke reviewed AXON Fleet 3 Front Dash Cam video footage by PPD Officers.

SA Burke reviewed the following PPD Officers Cruiser Dash Cam: Witness Officer (Ofc.) Chris Smith (Smith) PPD Cruiser #169, Involved Officer [REDACTED] PPD Cruiser # [REDACTED] and Involved Officer [REDACTED] PPD # [REDACTED]. These officers were a part of the Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which took place in the area of 10810 Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH, Cuyahoga County, 44130 on February 24, 2026. The male subject involved in the incident was later identified as Ricardo Yuuki Davis (Ricardo).

All video footage mentioned above has been placed in Axon Justice/Evidence.com and is available for review upon request. The times are relevant to the video-embedded timestamps (actual time).

SA Burke reviewed the video recordings and noted the following:

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13:39:53, February 24, 2026, Ofc. Chris Smith, Unit #568, PPD Cruiser #169 located Ricardo's red Toyota Corolla, JSF-3645 on Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH, AXON Fleet 3 Front Dash Cam, F X687J72N2

- **13:39:53:** Ofc. Smith observed Ricardo's red Toyota Corolla exiting Wal-Mart parking lot heading westbound on Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH.
- **13:40:01:** Ofc. Smith turned his cruiser and attempted to locate Ricardo's vehicle, told dispatch and other PPD Ofcs, **"I think I got the car up here."**
- **13:40:12:** Ofc. Smith pulled behind Ricardo's red Toyota Corolla, Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH (JSF-3645). Ofc. Smith radioed dispatch the plate number to dispatch.
- **13:40:20:** Ofc. Smith activated overhead lights/siren to initiate a traffic stop on Ricardo's Toyota Corolla.
- **13:40:37:** Ofc. Smith radioed to dispatch/other units that the PPD vehicle was not stopping, going the speed limit and the direction of travel.
- **13:40:57:** Red Toyota Corolla stopped in the westbound lane in the area of 10810 Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH
- **13:40:59:** Ofc. Smith radioed to dispatch, **"He stopped now in traffic"**
- **13:41:10:** Ofc. Smith exited cruiser and gave numerous orders to Ricardo, **"Turn the car off, turn the car off, turn the car off, turn the car off, turn the car off. Turn the car off, he's reaching."**
- **13:41:25:** Other PPD Officers arrived on scene as Ofc. Smith ordering commands for Ricardo to turn the car off.

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- 13:41:27: Ofc. Smith and other PPD Officers stating, **"He's reaching, he's reaching in the backseat, I think he has a gun."**

- 13:41:29: Driver's side door of red Toyota Corolla opened and Ricardo started to exit the vehicle.
- 13:41:30: PPD Officers ordered Ricardo to **"Drop it, drop it, drop it."**

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(Image #3, snippet above fully exited vehicle with weapon in right hand walking towards PPD Ofc.'s being ordered to "drop it, drop it," weapon in Ricardo's right hand.)

- **13:41:31:** PPD Officers still ordering Ricardo to **"Drop it, drop it."** Weapon still in right hand as Ricardo continued to walk towards officers, not complying with orders from PPD Officers

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- **13:41:31:** PPD Officers continued to order Ricardo to **"Drop it, drop it."** First gun shot was fired by a PPD Ofc.

- **13:41:32:** Multiple gunshots heard being fired at Ricardo by PPD Officers, weapon still in Ricardo's right hand, Ricardo fell to the ground.

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- **13:41:33:** Ricardo out of sight of Ofc. Smith's dash cam, on the ground of Brookpark Rd. Gunfire from PPD Officers ceased.
- **13:41:35:** PPD Officers ordered Ricardo not to move. PPD Ofc. radioed to dispatch, **"Shots fired, shots fired, male down."**
- **13:41:40:** PPD Officers approach Ricardo on the ground.
- **13:41:46:** PPD Ofc. radioed dispatch to, **"Start Parma Fire now."**
- **13:41:51:** PPD Officers appeared to be securing and accessing Ricardo.
- **13:41:59:** PPD Ofc. radioed, **"You guys want to advise Brooklyn, It is probably in Brooklyn's territory."**
- **13:42:01:** Numerous other PPD Officers arrived on scene.
- **13:42:02:** PPD Officers continued to render aid to Ricardo (Ricardo not observed due to dash cam view; however, officers' actions are observed).
- **13:44:08:** Dispatch advised Brooklyn Police Department (BPD) was going to respond to the scene.
- **13:46:01:** Parma Fire Department (PFD) Squad appeared on dash cam and arrived on scene.
- **13:47:29:** Ricardo loaded onto gurney by PFD Medics.
- **13:48:12:** Ricardo loaded into PFD Squad.
- **13:49:35:** PFD Squad leaves scene en route to the hospital.
- **13:50:16:** PPD Ofc. radioed, Ricardo's apartment is clear, **"There's just some evidence there that I want to preserve there."**
- **13:50:58:** Radio traffic asking where he (Ricardo) got shot. **PPD Ofc. responded, "Looks like uh, the face, neck area, one in the legs. There was definitely one in the stomach as well."**
- **13:52:08:** PPD Ofc. indicated witness vehicle was struck during the OICI by a bullet, KRR-3364
- **13:52:39:** PPD Ofc. indicated damage is to the driver side door of witness vehicle.

Images #1 through #6 are snippets from PPD Ofc. Chris Smith's front cruiser Axon Fleet 3 dash cam.

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13:40:26, February 24, 2026, [REDACTED] Unit # [REDACTED] PPD Cruiser # [REDACTED] responded to assist Ofc. Chris Smith on a traffic stop, welfare check on Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH, AXON Fleet 3 Front Dash Cam, F X6687J72NH.

- 13:40:17: [REDACTED] located red Toyota Corolla driven by Ricardo and Ofc. Smith following behind red Toyota Corolla.

- 13:40:31: [REDACTED] radioed to dispatch he was behind Ofc. Smith, Ofc. Smith cruiser lights activated.
- 13:40:37: Ofc. Smith radioed, **"He's not stopping."**
- 13:40:56: [REDACTED] pulled cruiser up to Ofc. Smith's cruiser, paralleling each other
- 13:40:59: Ricardo continued to move forward in his vehicle, not coming to a complete stop
- 13:41:00: Ofc. Smith pulled up closer to the rear of Ricardo's Toyota Corolla.
- 13:41:08: Ofc. Smith exited his cruiser, briefly hearing Ofc. Smith giving Ricardo commands to turn the car off.
- 13:41:23: [REDACTED] arrived on scene in cruiser # [REDACTED]
- 13:41:28: PPD Officer stated **"He's (Ricardo) reaching in the backseat."** Ofc. Smith moved to the rear of his cruiser with his service weapon drawn. PPD Ofc. further stated, **"I think he (Ricardo) has a gun in his hand."**
- 13:41:29: Ricardo started to open his car door.

- 13:41:29: Ricardo further opened his car door, "He (Ricardo) has a gun in his hand."
- 13:41:30: Ricardo fully exited his vehicle, PPD Officers shout, "Drop it, drop it," as Ricardo continued to walk towards officers.

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- **13:41:31:** Ricardo out of his vehicle, approaching officers with weapon in his right hand being ordered to **"Drop it."** Approximate first shot fired by [REDACTED]

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- **13:41:32:** Immediately after [REDACTED] first (1st) shot at Ricardo, Ricardo continued to approach PPD Officers, being ordered to, **"Drop it,"** weapon still being held in Ricardo's right hand, right arm bent, and elbow tucked in at a ninety (90) degree angle, weapon pointed at officers. PPD Officers Smith and [REDACTED] continue to engage Ricardo.

- **13:41:33:** Last shot was fired by PPD Officers, as Ricardo had fallen onto the roadway.
- **13:41:35:** PPD Ofc. radioed **"Shots fired, shots fired, male down."**
- **13:41:37:** PPD Officers approach Ricardo lying in the roadway.
- **13:41:38:** PPD Ofc. "kicked" weapon away from immediate area of Ricardo.
- **13:41:42:** PPD Officers secure Ricardo by handcuffing him behind his back.
- **13:41:47:** Learned PPD [REDACTED] radioed for **"You start Parma FD (PFD) now."**
- **13:41:53:** PPD Officers start to access Ricardo's injuries
- **13:42:02:** PPD Officers began to render aid to Ricardo.

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(Image #13, snippet above, Ofc. Sean Gilligan (Gilligan) picked up weapon Ricardo had been in possession of, secured, and placed on driver seat of Ofc. Smith's cruiser)

- **13:42:33:** Ofc. Gilligan picked weapon up Ricardo had been in possession of and placed it on driver's seat of Ofc. Smith's cruiser. Ofc. Gilligan appeared to have black rubber gloves on. Numerous PPD Officers continued to render aid to Ricardo.
- **13:42:49:** Ofc. Gilligan secured weapon Ricardo had been in possession of in Ofc. Smith's cruiser.
- **13:42:57:** Dispatch advised PPD Officers that Brooklyn PD was advised on OICI.
- **13:46:01:** PFD arrived on scene of OICI.
- **13:47:31:** Ricardo loaded on to the gurney by PFD medics and PPD Officers

Images #7 through #13 are snippets from PPD [REDACTED] front cruiser Axon Fleet 3 dash cam.

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13:41:21, February 24, 2026, [REDACTED] Unit # [REDACTED] PPD Cruiser # [REDACTED] responded to assist Ofc. Chris Smith on a traffic stop, welfare check on Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH, AXON Fleet 3 Front Dash Cam, F X686R5GPH. It should be noted, [REDACTED] AXON Fleet 3 Front Dash Cam is logged under Ofc. Marshall Gallo, Unit # [REDACTED]

- 13:41:21: PPD [REDACTED] arrived on scene in the area of 10810 Brookpark Rd., where PPD Ofc. Smith and [REDACTED] were already on scene of traffic stop, to check the welfare of Ricardo, who had been driving a red Toyota Corolla.
- 13:41:26: Ricardo reached and retrieved a weapon from the backseat of the vehicle. Weapon appeared to be in Ricardo's right hand.

- 13:41:28: PPD Officer radioed, "He's reaching in the backseat, I think he has a gun."

- 13:41:29: Ricardo opened driver side car door and exited vehicle.

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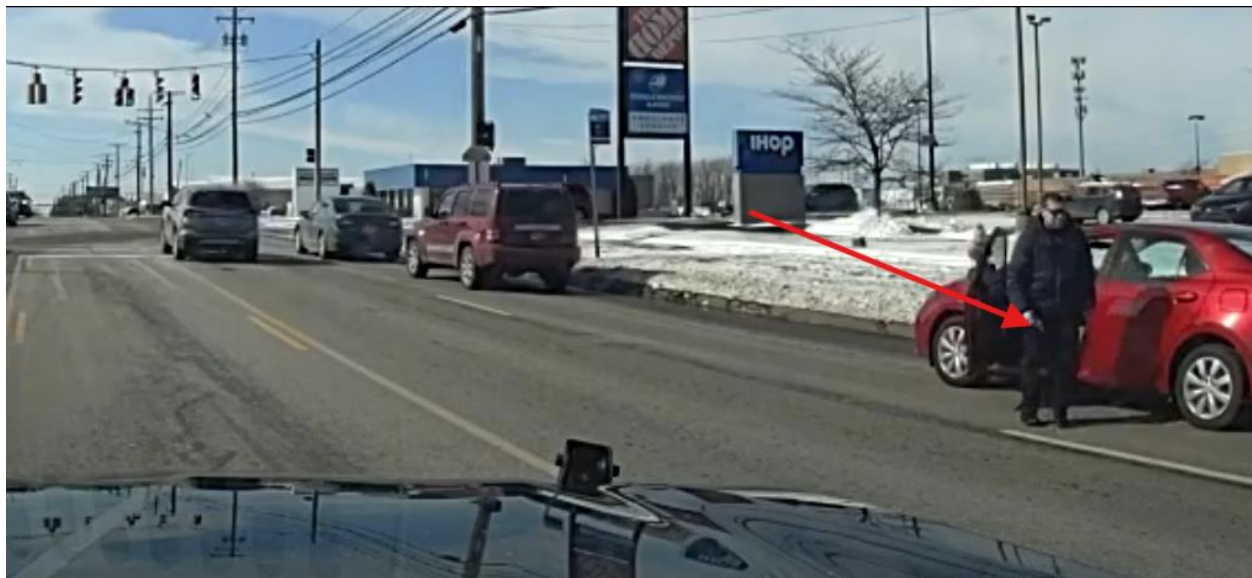
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- **13:41:31:** Ricardo out of his vehicle, weapon downward in Ricardo's right hand, approaching PPD Officers

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- **13:41:31:** Numerous orders from PPD Officers for Ricardo to, **"Drop it, drop it"** as Ricardo continued to towards officers.
- **13:41:32:** First (1st) shot fired at Ricardo from PPD [REDACTED], Ricardo continued to approach PPD Officers with weapon in right hand, not complying with PPD Ofc. orders to **"Drop it, drop it."**



(Image #19, snippet above, approximate first (1st) fired by PPD [REDACTED] Ricardo still approaching (walking towards) PPD Officers with weapon in right hand, not complying with orders to **"Drop it, drop it."**

- **13:41:32:** Further shots fired by PPD [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at Ricardo and Ricardo being struck. Weapon still being held in Ricardo's right hand, right arm bent, and elbow tucked in at a ninety (90) degree angle, weapon pointed at officers. PPD Officers Smith and [REDACTED] continue to engage Ricardo.

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(Image #20, snippet above, Further shots fired by PPD Officers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at Ricardo and Ricardo being struck, weapon still being held in Ricardo's right hand, right arm bent, and elbow tucked in at a ninety (90) degree angle, weapon pointed at officers. PPD Officers Smith and [REDACTED] continue to engage Ricardo.

- **13:41:33:** Ricardo fell onto the roadway and weapon came out of Ricardo's right hand and bounced off roadway.

- **13:41:33:** Last shot fired at Ricardo, Ricardo had fallen on the roadway

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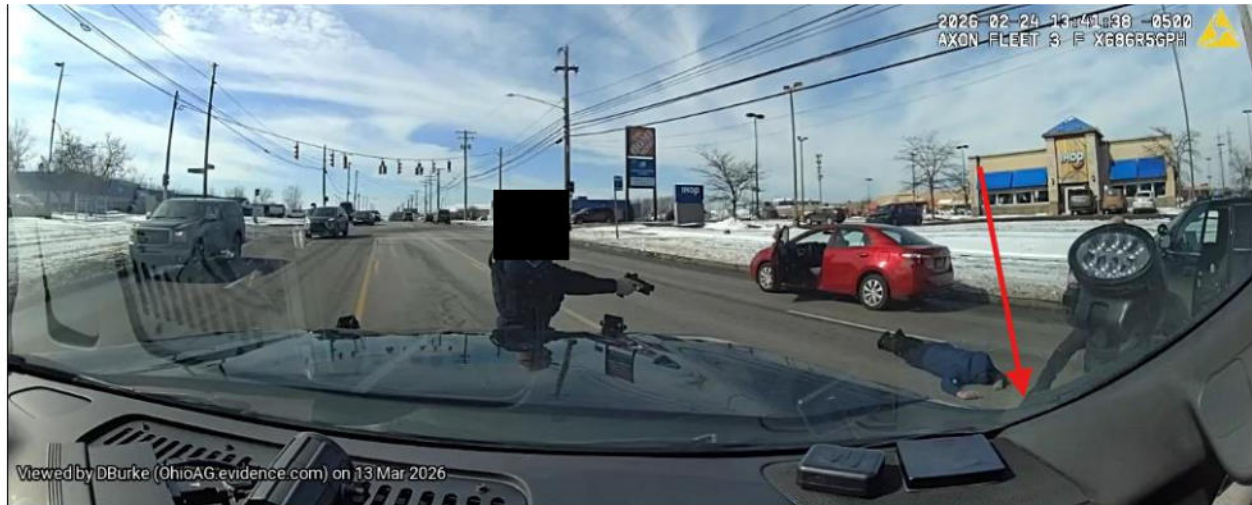
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- 13:41:35: PPD [REDACTED] radioed to dispatch, "Shots fired, shots fired, male down."
- 13:41:38: PPD Ofc. Renato Romanello (Romanello) kicked weapon away from Ricardo with right foot.

- 13:41:42: PPD Officers start to secure Ricardo.
- 13:41:47: PPD [REDACTED] radioed to dispatch, "Start Parma FD now."
- 13:41:53: PPD Officers started to assess Ricardo's injuries and check for any further weapons.
- 13:42:22: PPD [REDACTED] repositioned his cruiser to stop traffic on Brookpark Rd., out of sight of where OICI took place on the roadway.

ADDITIONAL FACTORS FOR EVALUATING THE VIDEO RECORDINGS

There are numerous other factors that need to be considered when reviewing and evaluating the videos and audio recordings of this incident. Those factors are:

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A. Video recording devices record within the video and sound capabilities available, and they record objectively. Video recordings lack the history, perspective, and interest of the people involved. The positions, angles, obstacles, lighting, and distance from the incident are also factors that need serious consideration.

B. Video recording devices also record more information about a particular scene or incident than the person(s) involved in the incident can process during the critical incident. Video recording devices rarely record an event from the same perspective of the officer. It captures the action but not the perception, decision making, focus, or intent of the officer. Video recordings often miss tactile cues or other actions of a subject.

C. The speed of the incident is remarkable. The speed and complexity of rapidly evolving situation(s) that occur during use of force encounters are difficult concepts to comprehend by only watching the video.
