#### Narrative:

On October 28, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (Valente) completed a review of the video captured from the body-worn camera (BWC) of Officer Brian Schmock (Officer Schmock) during this incident.

Amped Replay was used to review the videos.

SA Valente made working copies of the BWC videos and placed the copied videos in a folder on his BCI issued laptop. The working copies of the videos were used for the review.



The video began as Officer Schmock ran towards the subject's home on Yellowstone Road. Officer Schmock quickly arrived in front of the subject's residence where Ferrel Thomas (Ferrel) and Genisis Thomas (Genisis) were standing and talking with officers. Ferrel is the subject's father and Genisis is the subject's sister. Genisis could be heard complaining that the subject was not being moved from the scene into an ambulance.

Ferrel stated he wanted to go into his home and this request was denied by officers.




