On Wednesday, January 21, 2026, the North Olmsted Police Department (NOPD) requested Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) assistance at the scene of an officer-involved critical incident at 24496 Clareshire Dr., Apt. F, North Olmsted, OH 44070, Ohio. As part of that investigation, Special Agent (SA) Lurna McClintock was requested to attend the post-mortem examination of the decedent.
