Narrative:

On November 19, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (Valente) completed a review of the video captured from the body-worn camera (BWC) of University Heights Police Officer Brandon Manley (Officer Manley) during this incident.

Amped Replay was used to review the video.

SA Valente made working copies of the two BWC videos created by Officer Manley and placed the copied videos in a folder on his BCI issued laptop. The working copies of the videos were used for the review.

BWC VIDEO #1:

The Amped Replay software noted the following:

- The video was filmed at a rate of 29.97 frames per second.
- There was a total of 59,729 frames in the video.
- The video was 00:33:12.96 long.

The recording began as Officer Manley, who was in the passenger seat of a patrol car, arrived on scene. Officer Manley and his partner arrived after the officer-involved shooting occurred. Officer Manley approached the scene and assisted with crowd control. Officer Manley also spoke with the residents of 1295 Yellowstone Road and confirmed no residents of the home were struck by gunfire. No derivative productions were made from this recording.

The recording began as Officer Manley, was standing on Yellowstone Road speaking with another officer well after the officer-involved shooting occurred and the previous

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recording ended. It appeared Officer Manley unintentionally activated his BWC while shaking hands with and saying goodbye to officers just prior to clearing the scene.
