Narrative:

Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Cory Momchilov (Momchilov) was requested to package and photograph Jason Cain's (Cain) clothing and personal items. SA Momchilov was advised that Cain's clothing and items were currently in the drying room located at the Richfield office of BCI.

On December 18, 2024, at approximately 1100 hours, SA Momchilov removed Cain's clothing and items from the drying room.

SA Momchilov documented the items on a property receipt and photographed them. The following items were photographed and packaged.

- \$449.00 in U.S. Currency (\$410.00 recovered from wallet, \$39.00 recovered from pants pocket).
- Wallet-containing the following items:
 - Ohio driver's license belonging to Jason Cain
