once her daughter woke from her nap. stated that at approximately 1647 hours, she received a phone call from Dakota Schneider, who is Ronald's daughter from a prior relationship. Dakota asked her if she had spoken with Consuelo, to which she replied that she had not. Dakota went on to tell her that Ronald called her to inform her that he had just shot Consuelo "four times in the chest." She stated that Dakota told her Ronald said he shot Consuelo "three times with a handgun and one with a shotgun." stated that she responded to Mohawk Street immediately following her call with Dakota, and upon her arrival, she observed multiple police officers in the area. As she was parking in the Summit Academy Secondary School parking lot (across the street from 3013 Mohawk Street), she called Consuelo's phone, which was approximately 1648 hours. She said Ronald answered the phone. She asked him where Consuelo was, to which he replied, "She's laying on the ground dead." She responded by asking what he meant, to which he replied, "I shot her." She recalled Ronald saying, "You're never talking to her again." stated that she tried to call Consuelo's phone again at approximately 1655 hours, but Ronald answered and quickly hung up. She said she then called Ronald's phone. She said she pleaded with him to come outside. She said Ronald blamed her and told her, "It's all your fault." She said Ronald was angry that she did not bring her daughter over when he asked earlier. stated that she asked a police officer if she could talk to Ronald over the loudspeaker, which was denied. She stated that five or six officers approached her and inquired which doors were likely locked. She told the officers that the rear door does not lock. She stated that the officers went around to the rear of the residence, and she recalled that one of the officers was holding a shield. She said she heard one single gunshot. Several seconds later, she recalled hearing eight or nine gunshots. She opined that the first shot was Ronald shooting at the officers, and the other shots were from police officers returning fire. She said the officers "thankfully" shot and killed Ronald because "that's the best place for him." stated that Ronald also called his niece, Amy (Tolfree), earlier in the day. She said Consuelo informed her about the call when they last spoke on the phone. she learned through Consuelo that Ronald told Amy that he was depressed and wished to commit suicide, "whether it be self-inflicted or suicide by cops." said that Ronald had "multiple guns" inside the residence. SA Seitzman inquired about the sexual assault incidents that mentioned earlier in the interview. She stated that when she was five, "The motherfucker [Ronald] held me down and raped me. Again when I was six, and all through my entire childhood until just recently."
