DISPATCHED TO ASSIST LAW ENFORCEMENT ON PERSON BARRICADED INSIDE MOTEL ROOM - FIRING SHOTS AT PD. ADVISED TO STAGE AT THE EAGLES UNTIL SCENE SECURE

PER CAD NOTES FOR REFERENCE:

@1327hr - REPORTED PT LYING IN POOL OF BLOOD NEAR BED

@1243hr - REPORTED SUSPECT DOWN

@1352hr - PD REQ'D MEDIC 1 TO COME IN

AT APPROX 1352hr M1 CALLED TO THE SCENE BY PD AS THEY WERE MAKING ENTRY. PD SECURED SHOOTER AND WEAPONS AND SUMMONED THE MEDICS TO THE SHOOTER'S LOCATION AT APPROX 1352hr.

EMS ARRIVED AND MET WITH OFF-DUTY JTFD MEDIC (ALSO SWAT MEDIC) SCOTT APPLEGATE WHO WAS INVOLVED WITH THE SCENE IN ITS ENTIRETY. APPLEGATE ADVISED THE SHOOTER WAS LYING ON HIS LEFT SIDE IN MOTEL ROOM BETWEEN THE BED AND THE BATHROOM WALL. ADVISED PT WAS PULSELESS AND APNEIC, LAYING IN A POOL OF BLOOD AND EMESIS.

THE MOTEL ROOM WAS STILL VENTING OUT FROM MULTIPLE GAS CANISTERS THAT PD SHOT INSIDE IN ATTEMPT TO DISABLE THE PT. MEDIC APPLEGATE WAS WEARING GAS MASK. HE AND FF/MEDIC BRYAN ENTERED ROOM TO PROVIDE AN EXAM AND APPLY 4-LEAD. PT WAS FOUND UNRESPONSIVE, ASYSTOLE, PULSELESS, AND APNEIC IN A POOL OF BLOOD AND EMESIS. PT STILL WEARING CLOTHING. ABSENT CAROTID AND RADIAL PULSES & APNEIC. MULTIPLE GSW'S THROUGHOUT PT LEFT SIDE - BLOOD SOAKED CLOTHING NOT REMOVED. DUE TO THE SEVERITY OF WOUNDS AND ESTIMATED, EXTENDED DOWN TIME BEFORE ENTRY COULD BE MADE (IN ADDITION TO ACTIVE CRIME SCENE) EMS DETERMINED PT DOA.

AFTER ASSESSMENT, CREW LEFT THE IMMEDIATE CRIME SCENE IN MOTEL ROOM AND STEPPED OUT INTO PARKING LOT TO GATHER INFORMATION AND CONTACT MED CONTROL. PT INFO RECEIVED FROM U.S. MARSHALL'S OFFICE. CCF MERCY CALLED FOR PRONOUNCEMENT. REPORT GIVEN TO DR. GALLA AND SHE PROVIDED TIME OF DEATH AT 1403hr.

DUE TO MULI-AGENCY EVENT AND UNABLE TO GET CLEAR ANSWER REGARDING CORONER NOTIFICATION, M1 ADVISED DISPATCH TO HAVE CORONER CONTACT M1 FOR REPORT OF FIELD DEATH. C1 LATER ADVISED THAT OHIO BCI WOULD HANDLE ALONG WITH REST OF INVESTIGATION. AT THAT TIME, CORONER INVESTIGATOR HARRY CAMPBELL CALLED. I ADVISED HIM THAT OHIO BCI WOULD BE CONTACTING HIM DIRECTLY. HE DID ASK FOR BRIEF REPORT, ANYWAYS. I PROVIDED HIM WITH A VERBAL REPORT AND T.O.D. NOTIFICATION.
