Be it Remembered, That on the <u>2nd</u> day of <u>June</u>, <u>2022</u> Information was given to me, <u>Thomas P. Gilson</u>, <u>M.D.</u>, Medical Examiner of said County, that the dead body of <u>a man</u> supposed to have come to <u>his</u> death as the result of criminal or other violent means, or by casualty, or by suicide, or suddenly when in apparent health, or in any suspicious or unusual manner, (Sec. 313-11, 313-12 R.C. Ohio) had been found <u>in Emergency Room</u>, <u>University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center</u> in <u>Cleveland</u> of Cuyahoga County, on the <u>2nd</u> day of <u>June</u>, <u>2022</u>.

I viewed or caused to be viewed the said body at the Medical Examiner's Office. After the viewing and making inquiry into the circumstances that caused the death of the said person, I obtained further information, to-wit: (CPD #06924409) (UH #01313157). I also carefully examined or caused to be examined the said dead body at 8:30AM on the 3rd day of June, 2022 and I find as follows: to wit:

I, Thomas P. Gilson, M.D., Medical Examiner of said county, having diligently inquired, do true presentment make in what manner <a href="Demond Lebron Eskridge">Demond Lebron Eskridge</a>, whose body was at the Medical Examiner's Office on the <a href="3rd">3rd</a> day of <a href="June">June</a>, <a href="2022">2022</a> came to <a href="his</a> death. The said <a href="Demond Lebron Eskridge">Demond Lebron Eskridge</a> was <a href="divorced">divorced</a> (and not remarried), <a href="42 years">42 years</a> of age, a resident of <a href="Cleveland, Cuyahoga County">Cleveland</a>, <a href="Otion Union Thomas Programment of Thomas Pr

Upon full inquiry based on all the known facts, I find that the sald <u>Demond Lebron Eskridge</u> came to <u>his</u> death officially on the <u>2nd</u> day of <u>June</u>, <u>2022</u> in Emergency Room, University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center and was officially pronounced dead at 6:18 P.M., by Dr. Rushing. There is history that on June 2nd, 2022 at about 5:34 P.M., Cleveland Police and Paramedics responded to a call of an altercation with a male shot by Cuyahoga Metropolitan Housing Authority Police during legal intervention, at 3495 East 98th Street #703. On arrival, the male, identified as the said Demond Lebron Eskridge, of the same address, was found to have sustained gunshot wounds, and treatment was administered. This man was then transported to University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center where he was admitted to the Emergency Room at 6:15 P.M., with the aforementioned injuries. Treatment and drug therapy were administered, however, the said Demond Lebron Eskridge failed to respond and was pronounced dead at the aforementioned time and date. The County Medical Examiner's Office was notified and Esposito Mortuary Services was dispatched. This man was then transported to the Medical Examiner's Office where an autopsy was performed. That death in this case was the end result of gunshot wound of trunk with injuries of lung, liver, and spine, and was homicidal in nature.

Cause of Death:

Gunshot wound of trunk with injuries of lung, liver, and spine.
