Narrative:

On Friday, October 11, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received video footage from Medina County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) Captain Kris Conwill. SA Lieber was informed that the videos contained footage from the body-worn camera (BWC) of Deputy David McGurk (McGurk).

The times referenced in this report will refer to the elapsed time of the video.

SA Lieber reviewed the video recording and noted the following:

File title: **DavidMcGurk_202410052208_BWC2130724-0**

This video shows the body-worn camera (BWC) video of Deputy McGurk. The video is 9 minutes and 40 seconds in duration. No sound could be heard until 00:30. The camera was largely blocked by McGurk's seatbelt until 07:24. At 07:32, McGurk exited his cruiser. As McGurk walked toward the shooting scene, multiple law enforcement vehicles and an ambulance are seen. Nothing else noteworthy was observed.

At 09:40, the video ends.

The thumb drive containing the video footage was submitted to the physical BCI case file as item D for reference only.
