Narrative:

On Tuesday, December 03, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (SA Harasimchuk) received the "Firearms Trace Summary" reports from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearms that Charles Alexander (Alexander) possessed during the incident on November 11, 2024.

The ATF Trace Summary report #T20240586222 provided details about the Smith & Wesson, model M&P 15, serial number TT93874, including that it was purchased by Alexander on January 21, 2022.

The ATF Trace Summary report #T20240586223 provided details about the Smith & Wesson, model M&P 9 Sheild, serail number HLN5815, including that it was purchased by Alexander on April 9, 2016.

Additionally, an FBI National Crime Information Center (NCIC) check of the weapon was conducted by the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit to determine if the weapon was reported as being stolen. According to the report, the weapon was not stolen.
