Narrative:

On Monday, March 10, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Aja Chung (SA Chung) received Ohio BCI Laboratory report(s) for items of evidence submitted on February 18, 2025 for scientific analysis (laboratory case number 25-15246). Item 6.3 - Cartridges (7)


