Narrative:

On Friday, January 05, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received video footage from BCI SA Al Bansky. SA Bansky was informed that the videos contained footage from the body cameras recorded by the Canton Police Department (CPD).

SA Lieber reviewed the video recordings and noted the following:

This video is 11 minutes and 12 seconds in duration. The video is recorded by the body-worn camera (BWC) of Canton Police Department Officer (Ofc.) Kevin Sedares (Sedares). The time stamp at the beginning of the video is 12/05/2023 at 22:10:19.

The video begins showing the inside of a vehicle while driving. At 22:10:37, sound can now be heard. At 22:11:20, Sedares arrives at the scene of the shooting. As he parks his vehicle the video shows several officers standing in the area where Zachary Fornash (Fornash) was shot. See screenshot below.

Sedares then moves his vehicle to a different location. When Sedares exits his vehicle officers can be seen providing aid to Fornash. See screenshot below.



Sedares then assists in putting up crime scene tape.

At 22:21:31, the video ends.
