Narrative:

On Tuesday, February 24, 2026, at approximately 1700 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents (SA) Doug Burke (Burke) and Joe Lamping (Lamping) responded to 5433 Knollwood Drive Apartment 8, the residence of Ricardo Davis (Davis). The agents had been alerted to the presence of a suicide note affixed to Davis's apartment door. The Parma Police Department had detectives remain on scene until BCI agents could respond. It should be noted that the Parma Police Department attempted to obtain a search warrant for the residence. However, the prosecutor's office advised them that a warrant would not be justified under the circumstances of the investigation.

Upon arrival, agents met with several detectives from Parma Police Department. They directed the agents to the top floor of the apartment. Once outside of Davis's apartment, the agents were able to observe the suicide note in plain view. SA Lamping photographed the note and then collected it as evidence. The below images show the content of the note:

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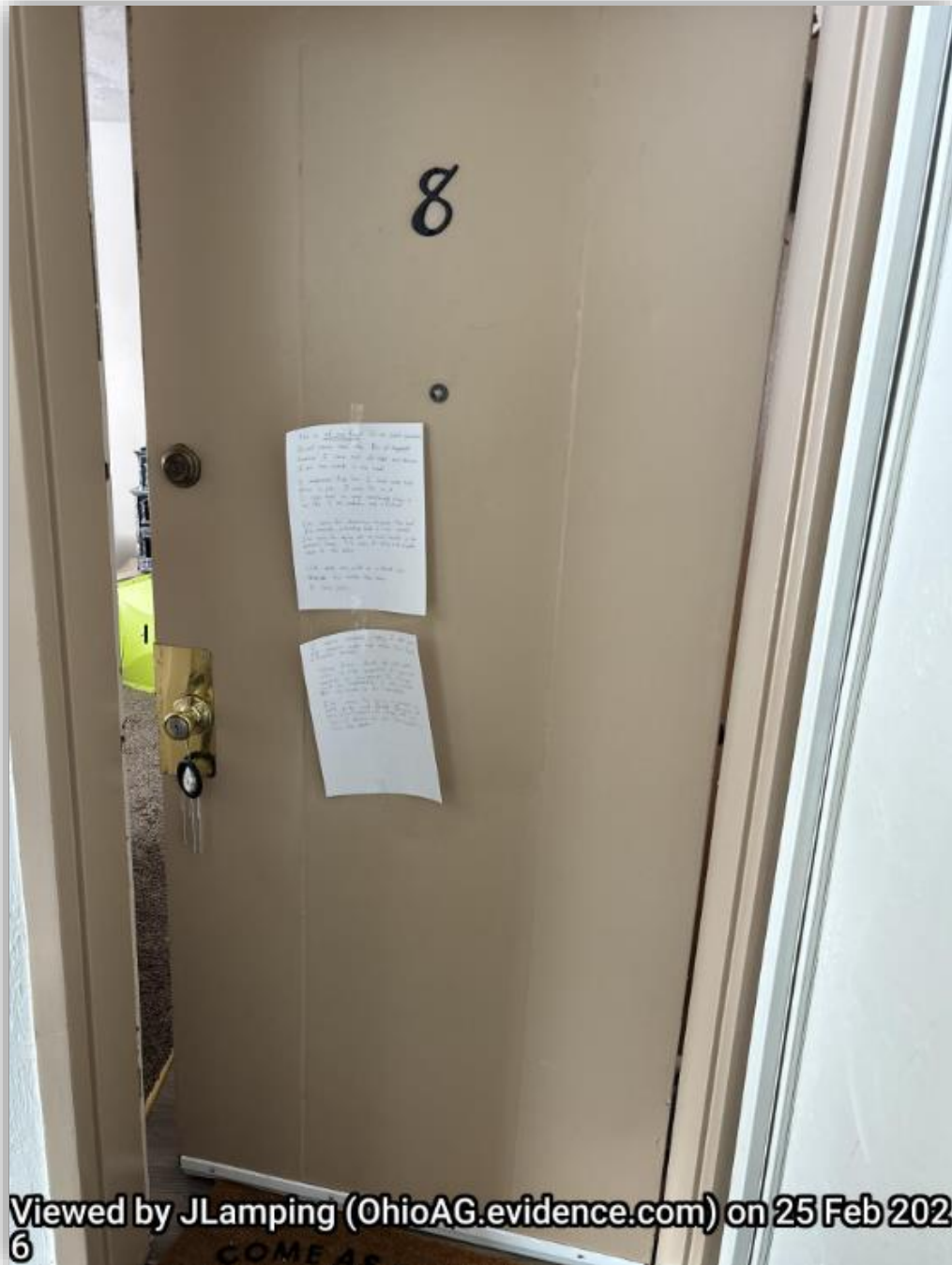


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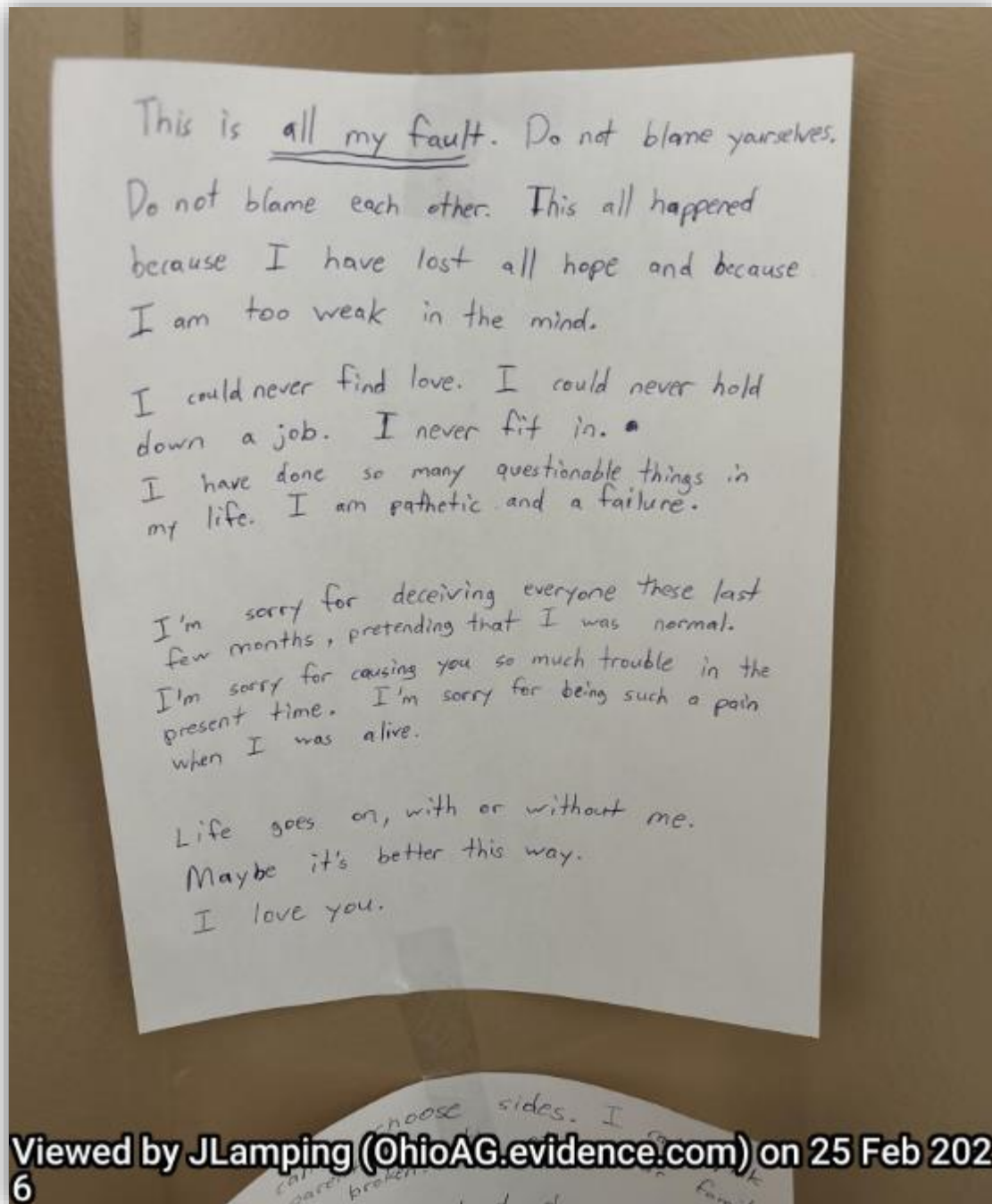

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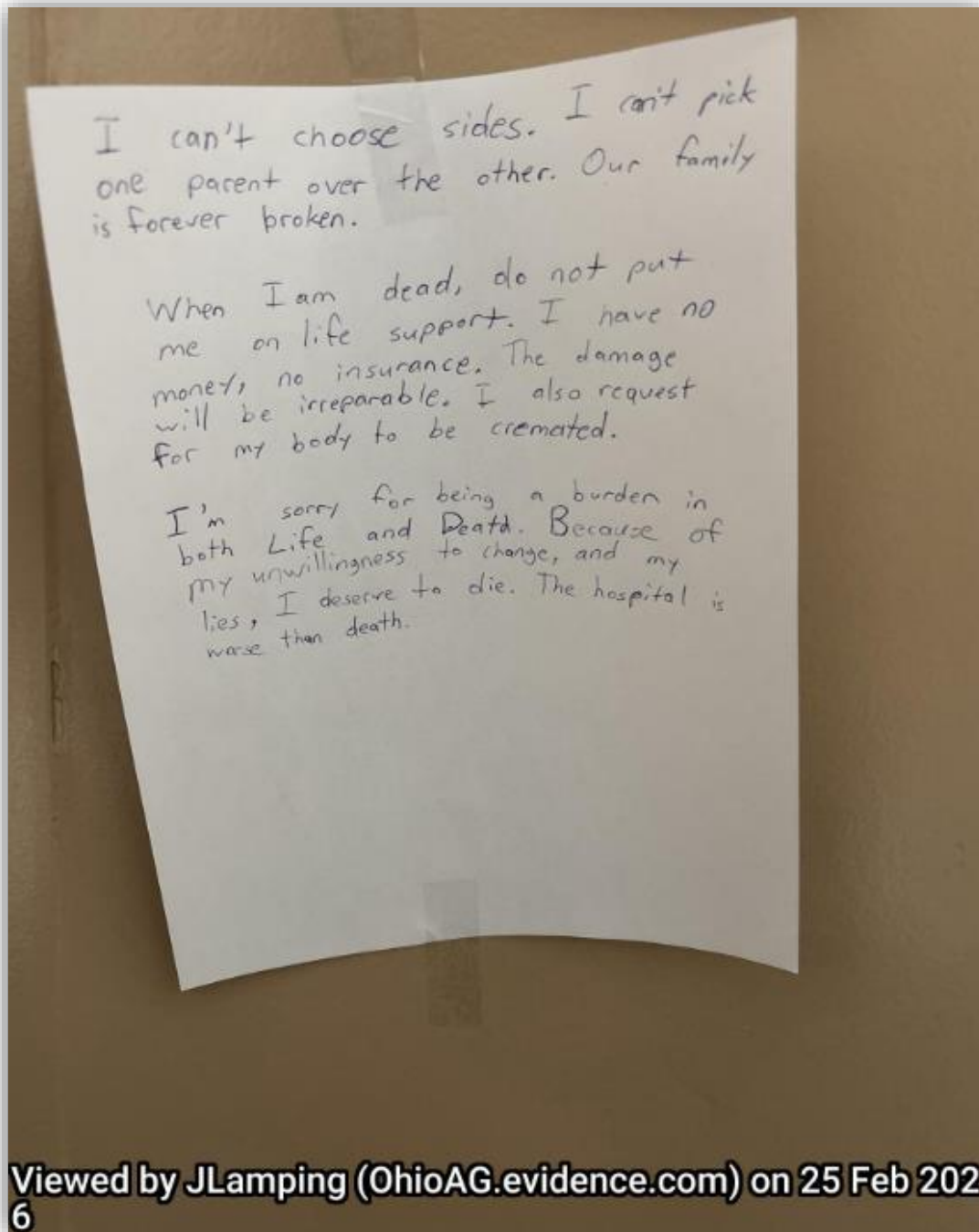


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After the note was removed from the door, it was examined. The rear side of each page did not appear to have any writing. The scotch tape used to secure the note to the door was folded onto the rear of the note to avoid damaging any of the writing. It should be noted that the content of the above note was in line with the content of an additional suicide note that was located in Davis' vehicle which was processed at the scene of the Officer Involved Critical Incident.
