On April 16th, 2025, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by the Norwood Police Department (NPD) to investigate an officer involved critical incident. As part of the investigation, Crime Scene Technician (CST) Holly Ryczek responded to the Norwood Police Department located at 4701 Montgomery Road, Cincinnati, OH 45212, to process the involved officers.

CST Ryczek arrived at the station at approximately 1530 hours. She was advised that multiple NPD officers were involved, however, none had discharged their duty weapons. All officers located at the station were observed to be in their agency issued uniforms and dressed as they were at the time of the incident. The specifics of each officer are detailed below:
