Narrative:

On Tuesday, December 20, 2022, the Marion County Sheriff's Office and Marion Police Department requested the assistance of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) with the investigation of an Officer Involved Critical Incident which occurred in LaRue, Marion County, Ohio. During the investigation, Special Agent Jason Snyder was provided with the personnel file of Marion County Sheriff's Deputy ██████████ ██████████. On Friday, January 6, 2023, Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Scott Stranahan reviewed Deputy ██████████'s personnel file and noted the following:

SAS Stranahan reviewed a file titled "Training Records for ██████████" Investigation revealed this file contained training records and Deputy ██████████'s Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (OPOTC) certificate.
