#### Narrative:

On Saturday, December 07, 2024, the Shelby Police Department (SPD) requested Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) assistance at the scene of an officer-involved shooting at 234 Mansfield Avenue, Shelby, Ohio. As part of that investigation, Special Agent (SAS) William Jones (SAS Jones) was requested to attend the post mortem examination of the decedent, Tyler Jacobs. The examination was conducted on December 9, 2024 at the Montgomery County Coroner's Office in Dayton, Ohio. The post mortem examination was conducted by Dr. Donald Higgs.

The following observations were made during the course of the autopsy:

Jacobs suffered possibly to the following areas of the body.



SAS Jones requested to receive a copy of the full autopsy and toxicology reports once available.

As a result of the autopsy, the following items of evidence were collected and transferred to the custody of SAS Jones:
