Narrative:

On Wednesday, December 23, 2020, Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Kevin Barbeau arrived at Columbus Division of Police (CPD) Headquarters (120 Marconi Blvd., Columbus, Ohio) in order to meet with CPD Detective Terry McConnell. Also present were BCI Special Agents Rick Ward and Perry Roeser. Investigators were meeting to collect information regarding an Officer-Involved Critical Incident, which occurred prior to this date involving CPD Officer Adam Coy and Officer Amy Detweiler. During said OICI Ofc. Coy fired his firearm striking Andre Hill, who eventually died from injuries he sustained.

SAS Barbeau took possession of a thumb drive from Det. McConnell, which was said to include CPD body worn camera (BWC) recordings for those officers on scene of the OICI, which occurred at 1062 Oberlin Drive, Columbus, Ohio. Specifically, Ofc. Coy's and Ofc. Detweiler's BWC video was included on the thumb drive.

SAS Barbeau transported said thumb drive and provided a download of the same to Deputy Director Matthew Hilbert. The purpose was to enter the downloaded BWC videos for analysis by David Loomis, Ohio Attorney General Forensic Audio/ Visual Analyst.

SAS Barbeau then transported the thumb drive to BCI (London), where it was entered into the physical casefile.
