**Narrative:**

On August 17, 2024, at approximately 0200 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jesse Bynum (Bynum) responded to the Akron Police Department (APD) to meet with the involved officer and collect evidence relevant to the August 17, 2024, officer-involved shooting.

SA Bynum met with APD [REDACTED] and APD [REDACTED]. Also present was FOP representative Brian Lucy (Lucy).

Lucy reported [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had mild injuries but were not treated during the incident. SA Bynum took photos of both officers and collected the uniforms.

Lucy indicated both officers were equipped with Body Worn Cameras (BWC). He confirmed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had their BWCs on and recording during the incident.

[REDACTED] firearm and all the magazines he had on him at the time of the shooting were collected by APD Sergeant Miller and transferred to SA Lurna McClintock at the scene as noted in the investigative report titled "2024-08-17: Initial Scene Processing". SA McClintock completed a property receipt which has been attached to this report.

At approximately 0440 hours, SA Bynum took possession of the uniform from [REDACTED] which included a duty belt with holster, belt keeper, handcuffs, flashlight, mag pouch, handcuff case, and vehicle key. [REDACTED] pants included an inner belt, notebook, gloves, and a field test pouch. [REDACTED] vest included shears, taser, badge, pen, handcuff key, knife, 2 tourniquets, OC Spray, flashlight, police markings, and a radio. Lastly SA Bynum collected [REDACTED] boots and uniform shirt. Once everything was collected SA Bynum completed a property receipt, which has been

attached to this report, to [REDACTED] for the items. It was indicated that there were scuffs on the boots from the incident and dirt on the left leg of the uniform pants. [REDACTED] sustained injuries that were photographed to include an abrasion on his right elbow.

At approximately 0457 hours, SA Bynum took possession of the uniform from [REDACTED] which included a duty belt with holster, two mag pouches, asp, and Taser. [REDACTED] vest included badge, pen, handcuff key, knife, tourniquets, police markings, belt keeper with three keys, and a radio. Lastly SA Bynum collected [REDACTED] boots, pants, and uniform shirt. Once everything was collected, SA Bynum completed a property receipt, which has been attached to this report, to [REDACTED] for the items. It was indicated that there was blood on the pants from the incident. [REDACTED] sustained injuries that were photographed to include a laceration on his forehead and one to his left hand along with a red mark on his left forearm.

SA Bynum transported the items from APD back to the scene and transferred custody to SA McClintock. SA Bynum completed a property receipt which has been attached to this report.
