## Narrative:

On February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2025, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations (BCI) was requested by the Miami Township Police Department (MTPD) to investigate an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI). It was reported that the MTPD responded to Miami Township, Ohio, 45342 (Scene 1), for a male threatening family members with a knife. Upon arrival, officers encountered Jayden Stephenson and an OICI occurred (see Crime Scene Technician Holly Ryzeck's *Scene Processing* report for additional information).

Crime Scene Technician (CST) Dylan Wical was assigned to assist with the documentation of the involved officers at the MTPD headquarters. CST Wical arrived on scene at approximately 1642 hours and photographed the officers as they were upon his arrival. The officers were observed to be in their agency issued uniforms. The specifics of each officer are detailed below:

OICI. His service weapon was a Glock 45 (S/N: 9mm semi-automathandgun with a mounted Holosun sight (S/N: MS093007) and a TLR-7X Streamlight (S/N: 188383A). CST Wical observed one cartridge in the chamber and 11 cartridges in the seated magazine. The handgun, magazine, and cartridges were collected as Item 2. His service taser was a Taser 7 (S/N: with a sticker on the bottom of the grip. CST Wical observed both cartridges seated in the taser, however both probes were absent.	er
- Miami Township Police Department: reportedly discharged his less lethal shotgun during the OICI. The less lethal shotgun was reportedly left at the residence where the OICI occurred. CST Winspected his service weapon and two spare magazines. His service weapon a Glock 45 (S/N: 9mm semi-automatic handgun. CST Wical observone cartridge in the chamber and 17 cartridges in the magazine. His two spar magazines were inspected and were found to be fully loaded.	ical was ⁄ed

No further action was taken with the officers involved. CST Wical photographed witnessing Officer Morgan Spencer (#127) and Officer Crystal Rankins (#78). Their service weapons and magazines were inspected and were found to be fully loaded. Sgt. Todd gave CST Wical Ofc. Rankin's jacket (with suspected blood), handcuffs, and a pair of bloody gloves in separate paper bags. These items were documented with photography and were returned to MTPD. Both involved service tasers were documented with photography and were returned to MTPD.
