Narrative:

On May 22, 2026, at approximately 1000 hours, Crime Scene Technician (CST) Miller returned to 905 E. Warren St., Bucyrus, Ohio. Present at the location were Chief Dorsey of Bucyrus Police Department, [REDACTED] the homeowners of 905 E. Warren Street, and representatives from State Farm Insurance. A signed consent form from [REDACTED] was obtained and uploaded into Matrix. Due to the condition of the residence, it was requested for BCI to complete their examination before other individuals entered the residence. CST Miller provided [REDACTED] with a contact number in case she were to leave the property and wanted to revoke consent at any time.

Special Agent (SA) Roberts arrived a short time later.

The residence was secured with plywood boards. Chief Dorsey directed the city maintenance department to remove a portion of the boarding from the back door to allow investigators to gain entry into the structure. A follow-up examination was conducted by SA Roberts and CST Miller. A secondary scan of the primary bedroom was completed using a BLK scanner on high density settings.

Three (3) additional items of evidence were located on the floor in the southeast bedroom.

Copper/lead Fragments

Four (4) "LC 23" cartridge casings

One (1) "LC 23" cartridge

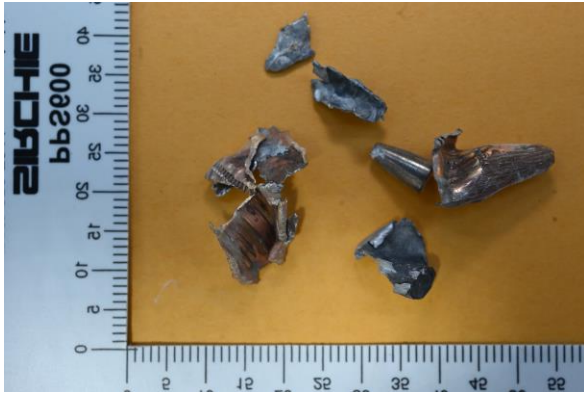


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All photographs and scan data were uploaded into Axon and will serve as the master images. A signed copy of the evidence inventory was obtained, and a copy was given to Kacie Kalb. Investigators cleared the scene at approximately 1200 hours.

CST Miller transported the evidence to the Bowling Green BCI office where they were secured. A copy of the consent form and evidence inventory list was left with [REDACTED]

CST Miller then submitted the fragments and four (4) "LC 23" cartridges to the lab for analysis. Please see the attached laboratory submission sheet for further details.

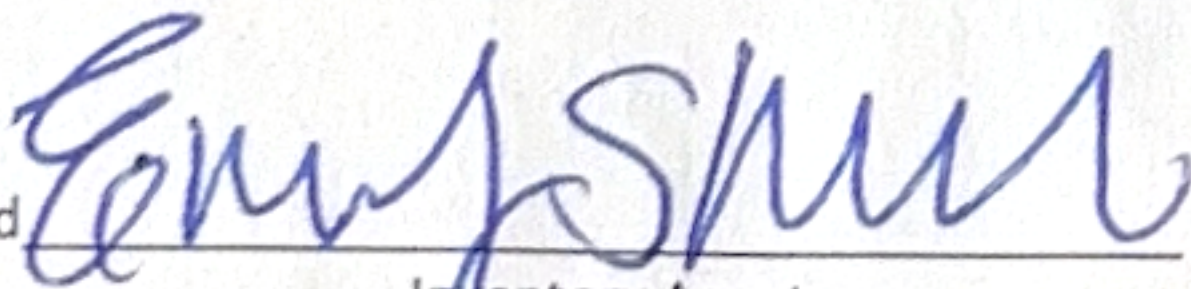

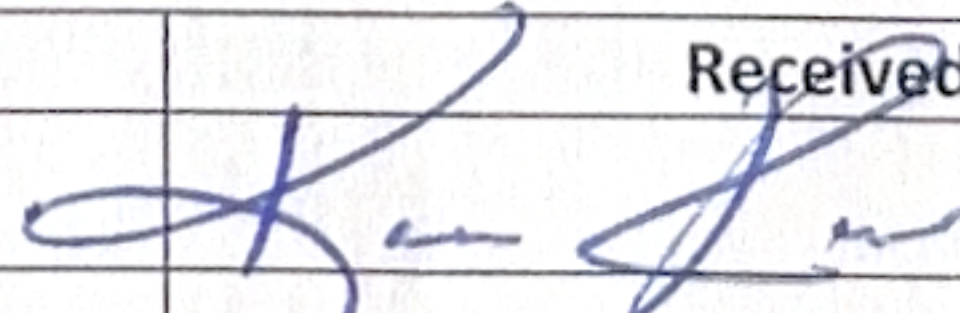
